1. Introduction

This document sets out the audit and inspection programme of DG Health and Consumers for the second half of 2010. It provides for an update on the 2010 plan published earlier this year, taking account of the delivery to date and of modifications that had to be made to that plan.

There is always a degree of uncertainty attached to any SANCO inspection plan. Of necessity, it must remain flexible to enable it to respond to emergencies, other urgent issues and unforeseen circumstances. As in previous years, adjustments to the plan will be required as the year progresses. Inspections in response to emergencies can only be made by cancelling or postponing planned missions. Also, the performance of certain inspections will depend on the timely availability of the required resource and expertise.

2. Number and Distribution of Audits and Inspections

As shown in table 1, a total of 116 audits and inspections are planned for the second half of 2010. This figure includes the specific audits which supplement the general audits planned in 10 Member States in 2010 (see Chapter 3. <u>Audits and Inspections in Member States</u>).

Audits and inspections in the food safety area make up the main part of the programme (66%). However, in line with the "farm to fork" approach, a large number of food safety inspections naturally also cover animal health and/or welfare elements. 11 and 6% of inspections, respectively, will specifically focus on controls in the animal health and welfare areas, and a further 8% of inspections are targeted at phytosanitary controls. General follow-up missions make up 9% of the planned audits and inspections.

Table 2 provides an overview on the geographical breakdown of audits and inspections in the second half of 2010.

52% of the audits and inspections will take place in the European Union. In EFTA countries, 4% of inspections are planned, while 5% of inspections will take place in candidate countries, and 39% in other third countries. Taking into account the 12 audits and inspections dealing with Member States' import control systems, overall, controls with respect to third countries' export of feed, food, plants and animals amount to more than 50% of the programme.

3. Audits and Inspections in Member States

As outlined above, the FVO will carry out 10 general audits in the framework of the Official Feed and Food Controls Regulation¹ in 2010, namely in Bulgaria, the Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Italy, Luxembourg, Malta, Poland, Romania and Sweden. Thus, 2010 will conclude a first cycle of general audits to all 27 Member States, supplemented by specific audits across all main control systems.

In the remaining 17 Member States, inspections will mainly focus on follow-up to issues identified in previous audits and inspections.

4. Inspections in EFTA Countries

Inspections in EFTA countries will be carried out in the framework of the agreement on the European Economic Area (EEA agreement) and agreements between the European Union and Switzerland. The inspection to Norway will be a joint mission between the EFTA Surveillance Authority (ESA) and the FVO. Iceland, following its application for EU membership, is a potential candidate for accession to the EU. Therefore, one inspection to Iceland is planned in the context of enlargement.

5. Inspections in Candidate Countries

The Food and Veterinary Office continues to evaluate the progress candidate countries are making in their preparations for accession. The second half of 2010 will see inspections to Croatia, Turkey and the former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia on a wide scale of food safety and animal health issues. The FVO will also carry out a general follow-up mission to Croatia to update its country profile and to review the progress on follow-up to FVO recommendations.

6. Inspections in Third Countries

In third countries, the FVO needs to verify that competent authorities correctly apply relevant EU standards or their equivalent with respect to animals, plants and products intended for export to the European Union.

While the main part of these inspections is targeted at a review of existing approvals of major trade partners and follow-up to previous missions, there are also a number of new requests for approval which will need to be evaluated. The readiness of application files (such as, for example, timely replies by competent authorities to pre-mission questionnaires), but also certain specific regional circumstances (e.g. security considerations), are major conditions for the completion of the inspection programme. Therefore, a number of third country inspections can only be programmed provisionally at this stage.
