**Notes:**

In general:

- Column 1 (and of course 3) refers to long transports only.
- In column 1, no inspections at the slaughterhouse are included because 1) there is no separate registration of long and short transports, and 2) it is not registered if the truck was present and inspected. This will be solved next year.

Table 2: Category of non-compliance:

- Inspections during and after transport may result in more infringements per check; here the number of infringements is registered and not the number of inspections.
- At the place of departure, there is no central registration of non-compliances. These are always corrected or the transport is cancelled.
- "6. Other" covers driving and resting periods of drivers, length and height of the truck, Identification and registration, etc.

Table 3: Category of action taken:

- Penalties imposed includes measures such as administrative fines, charges under penalty payment and written warnings
- Enforcement & information exchange covers all other exchange, including complaints from other Member States.
