# Movie 1: Know your expiration dates

Hi there! Did you know there are two kinds of expiration dates?

One is 'Best before:', meaning after the date you should use your eyes, smell and taste to decide if it's still good.

Then there's 'Use by:' this means it should only be used before or on the date listed.

In other words, you should treat the two dates differently.

Join the Food Waste Free movement!



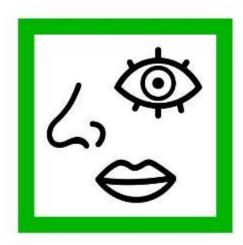
### Movie 2: Best Before
