






State of Play

- Sweden and Finland have a full ban in place.
- Germany, Denmark, France and Netherlands active strategies.
- CAs in ten Member States considering good practices in developing future strategy.
- Farm assessments already in place in 4 MS
 4 other MS planning to put in place,
 - 2 more awaiting risk assessment tools,
 - 1 will ask farm advisory service to perform.







"How will we achieve this?"

Tail Docking%:

DK (industry estimate) 97%

IRL (2010 SH study) 99%

PT 65%

LT 50%

Not recorded in almost all MS: Need to measure to manage it.

CA + industry + funding
