**AGENDA OF THE EU PREPARATORY MEETING ON 19 JUNE 2015
FOR THE WTO SANITARY AND PHYTOSANITARY COMMITTEE OF JULY 2015**

The meeting will prepare the 63rd regular meeting of the WTO Committee on Sanitary and Phytosanitary measures (SPS Committee) that will take place at the Centre William Rappard, Geneva on **15-16 July 2015**. Informal meetings on private standards and on the 4th Review of the WTO SPS Agreement will take place on 14 July and the informal meeting on risk communication on 15 July in the morning.

At the preparatory meeting of 19th June, the European Commission (COM) intends to discuss with Member States (MS) the main points of the agenda of the next SPS Committee. At this stage, only the preliminary agenda is available. The final agenda will be circulated by the WTO Secretariat on 3 July 2015.
