### Requirements for imports of food of animal origin from UK As any other third country, UK must be listed for:

animal	health
pu	irposes

Art. 8 of Council Directive 2002/99/EC on animal health rules governing the production, processing, distribution and introduction of products of animal origin for human consumption

#### public health purposes

- Art. 6(1)(a) of Reg. 853/2004 on specific hygiene rules for food of animal origin;
- Art. 6(1)(b)(i) of Reg. 853/2004 and Art. 12 of Reg. 854/2004 for the listing of establishments
- Art.11 of Reg. 854/2004 on specific rules for the organisation of official controls on products of animal origin intended for human consumption

# having a residue control plan approved

Chapter VI of Directive 96/23/EC on measures to monitor certain substances and residues in live animals and animal products

#### Meeting the food hygiene requirements

Art. 4 to 6 of Reg. 852/2004 on hygiene of foodstuffs

Art. 3, 4, 5, 7 and 8 of Reg. 853/2004 specific hygiene rules for food of animal origin.



**The flexibility provisions no longer apply** (Art. 13(3) of Reg. 852/2004, Art. 10(3) of Reg. 853/2004 and Art. 17(5) of Reg. 854/2004)





## Business operators are responsible for imports of food of animal origin

Mandatory controls in Border Inspection Posts	Commission Decision 2009/821/EC on a <i>list of approved border inspection posts</i> , on <i>rules</i> on the <i>inspections</i> carried out by Commission veterinary experts and laying down the veterinary units in Traces
Each consignment undergoes documentary and identity checks and, at an appropriate frequency, physical checks	Commission Decision 94/360/EC on the <i>reduced</i> frequency of physical checks of consignments of certain products to be implemented from third countries
Each consignment has to be accompanied by a certificate in compliance with EU food legislation	Art. 14 of Reg. 854/2004; Art. 9 of Council Directive 2002/99/EC on the <i>animal</i> health rules governing the production, processing, distribution and introduction of products of animal origin for human consumption
