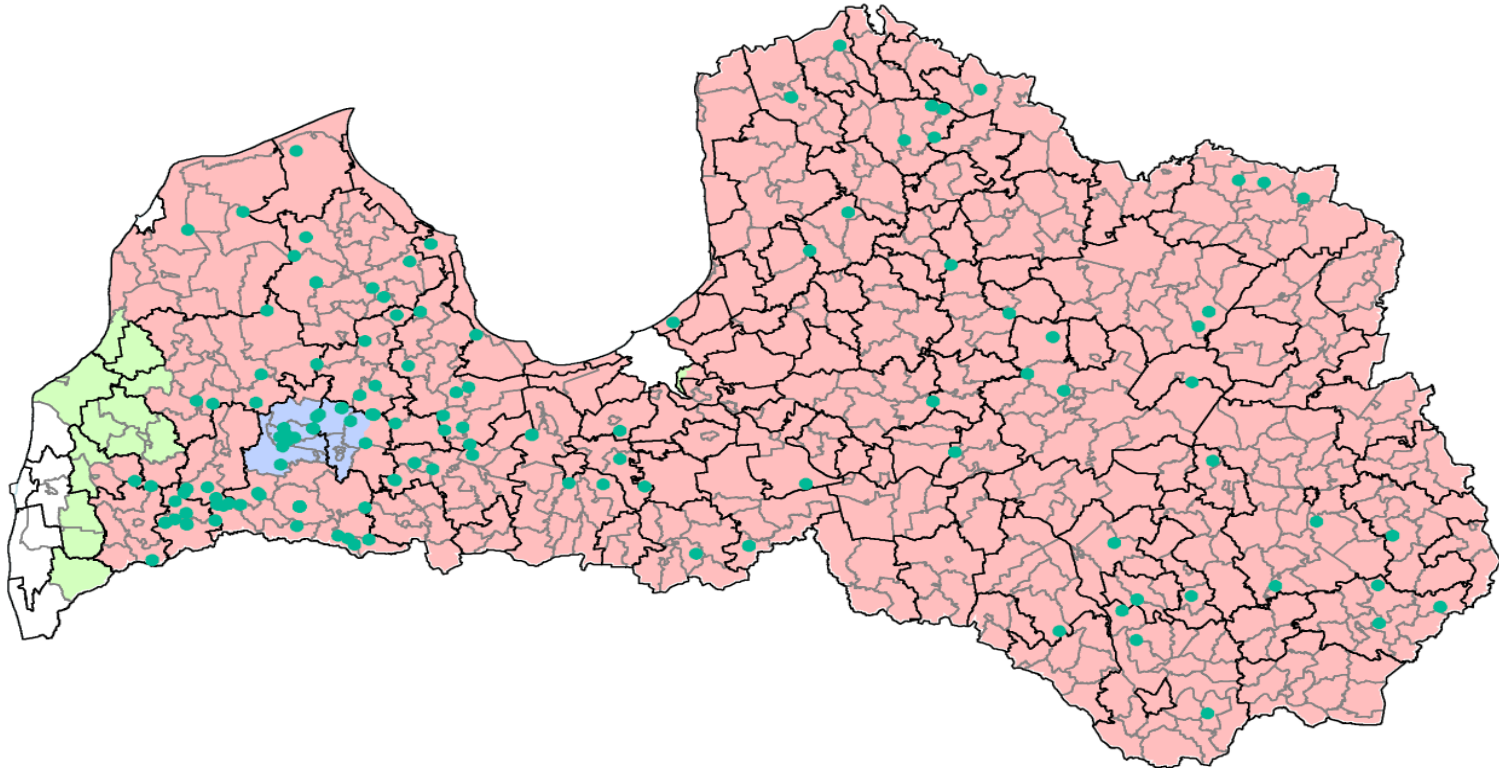

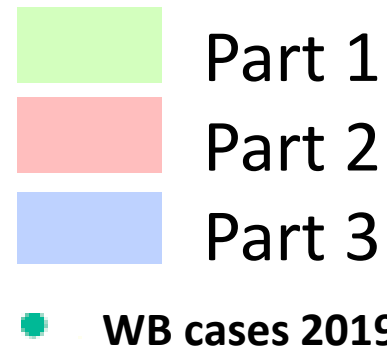

Wild boar cases in 2019 (08.07.)



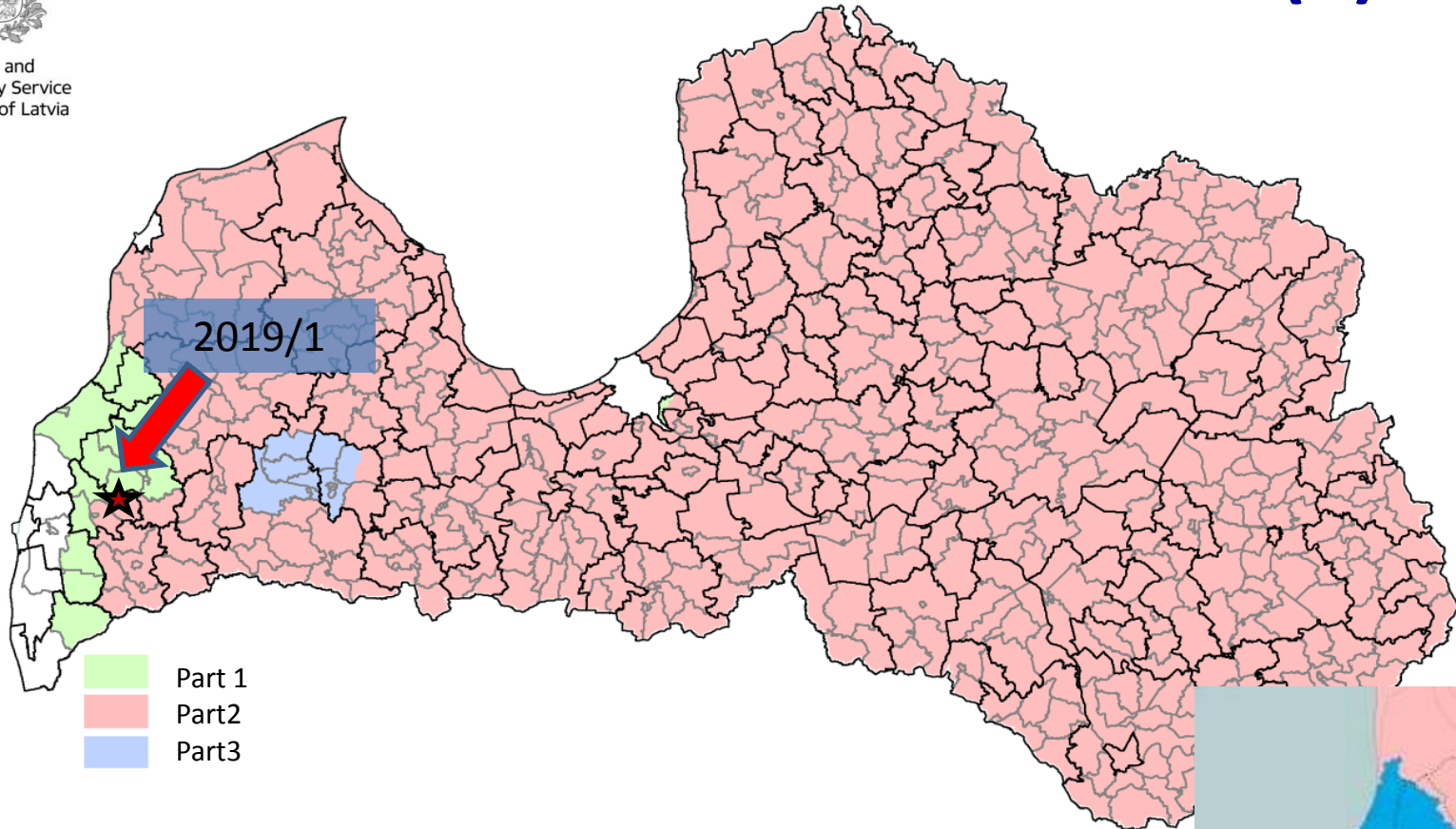

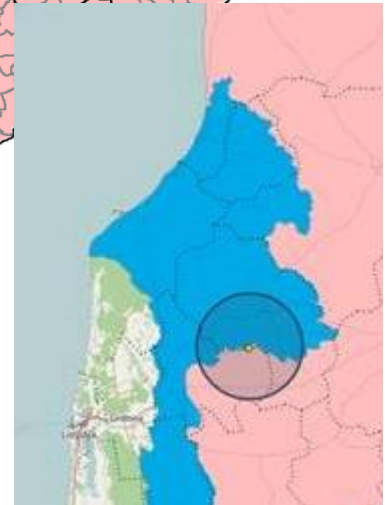

1st Outbreak in 2019 (1)



Farm of 52 pigs (6 sows)
Suspicion: 5th July (morning)
Confirmation – 5th July
Depopulation & disposal – 6th July





1st Outbreak in 2019 (2)

- **Measures according to Council Directive 60/2002/EC are in place**
- **Stamping out and primary disinfection carried out on July 6**

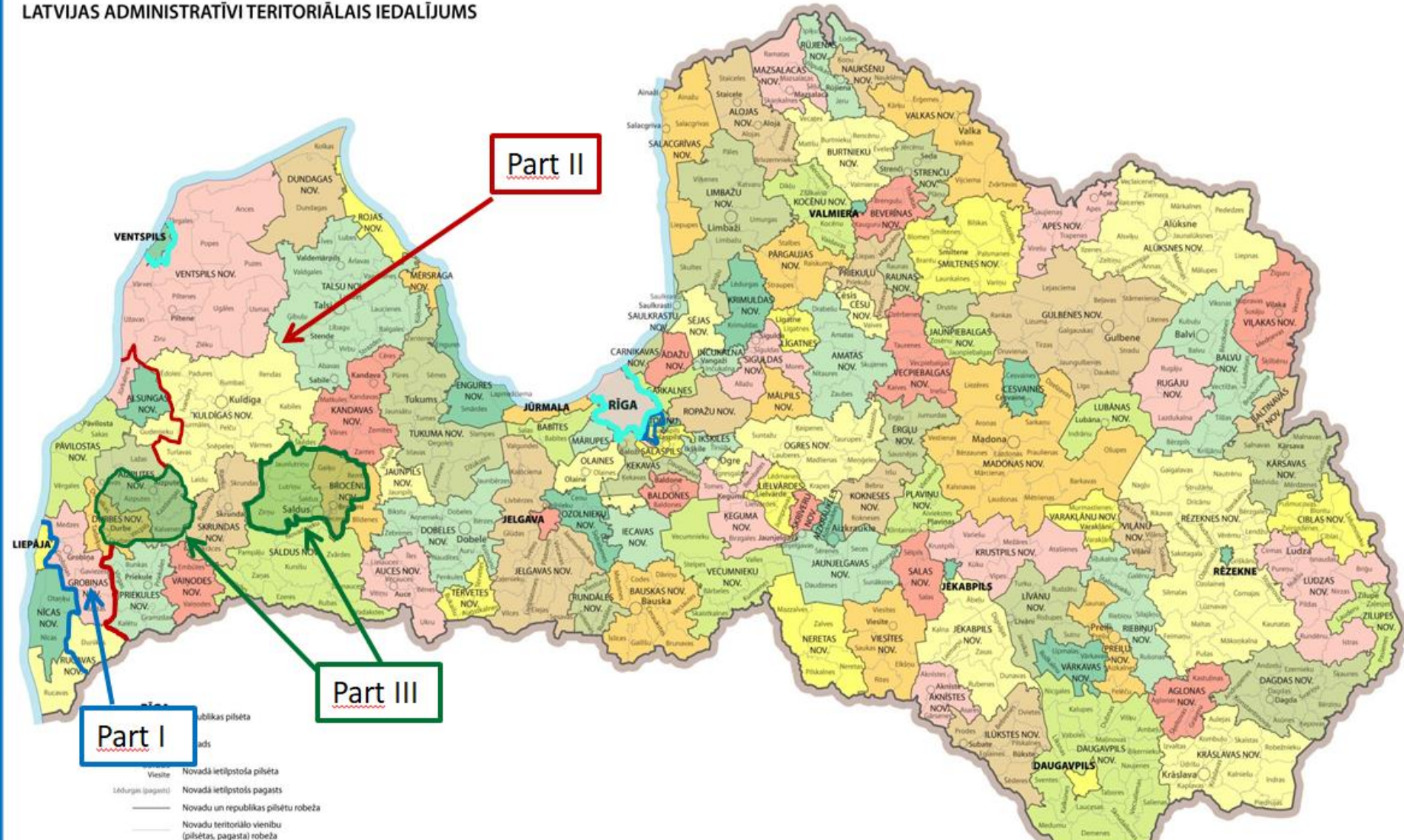
Summary of preliminary results of epidemiological inquiry (epidemiological investigation is ongoing):

- **infected wild boar in particular area**
- **no direct contact to wild boar**
- **biosecurity**
