1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS

There were no serious violations in the year 2017. Only non-systemic, individual cases of violations were detected, which were mostly related to incorrectly completed documents. Several cases were related to inappropriate means of transport, including one case related to improper ventilation where a big number of dead day-old chicks during the trip was detected. Corrective measures were applied to avoid animal welfare violations in the future. The cases, which involved transporters authorized by other Member States, were reported as laid down in Article 26 of Regulation 1/2005.

2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED UNDER POINT 1.

The action plan involves organising annual training for SFVS official veterinary inspectors who perform the official control of animals during transport.
