Commission First impressions of implementing the implementing acts under the 16:45 -See above OCR (discussion with Member 17:15 States) Future work: COM made a presentation on the state of play of its internal reflections as regards new model certificates to replace the current ones Requests from Member States as (Article 90 oif the OCR and Article 238 of the AHL). As for empowerments regards the future work on 17:15 -7 not used so far, MS mainly suggested that focus should be put on PDOs, PGIs, implementing acts (new model 17:55 TSGs (Article 26), traceability of samples (Article 46), presentation of official certificates etc.) consignments in BCPs (Article 49) and a European food fraud reference centre (Article 97). MS were invited to submit written comments within the weeks to follow, and 17:55 -Conclusion of the meeting informed that the next OCR expert group meeting would be planned for the 18:00 second half of April 2020.
