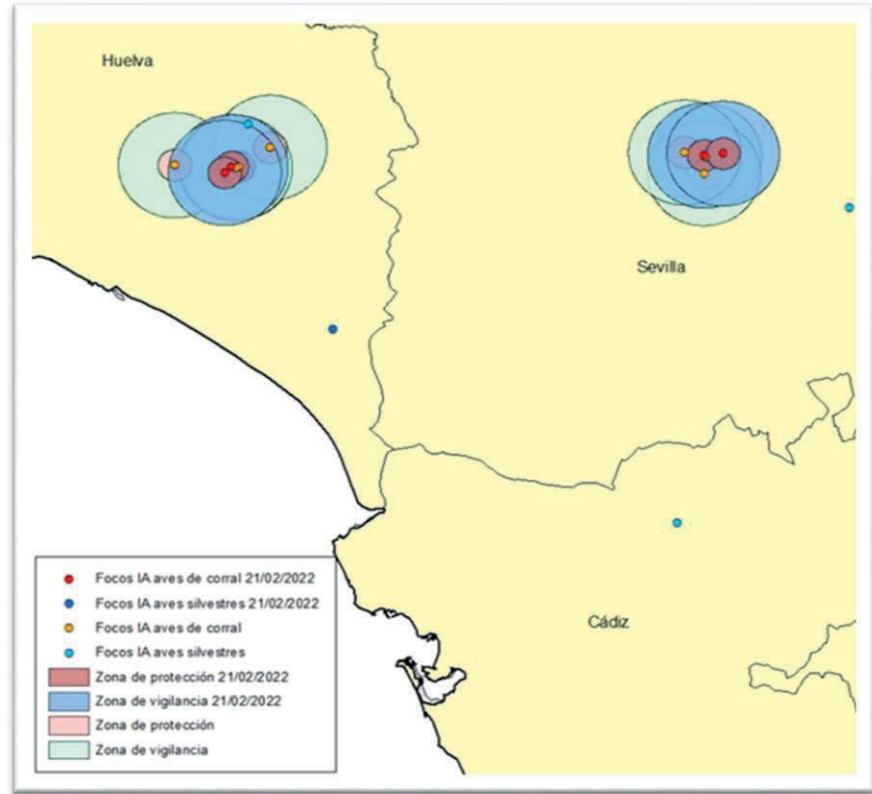

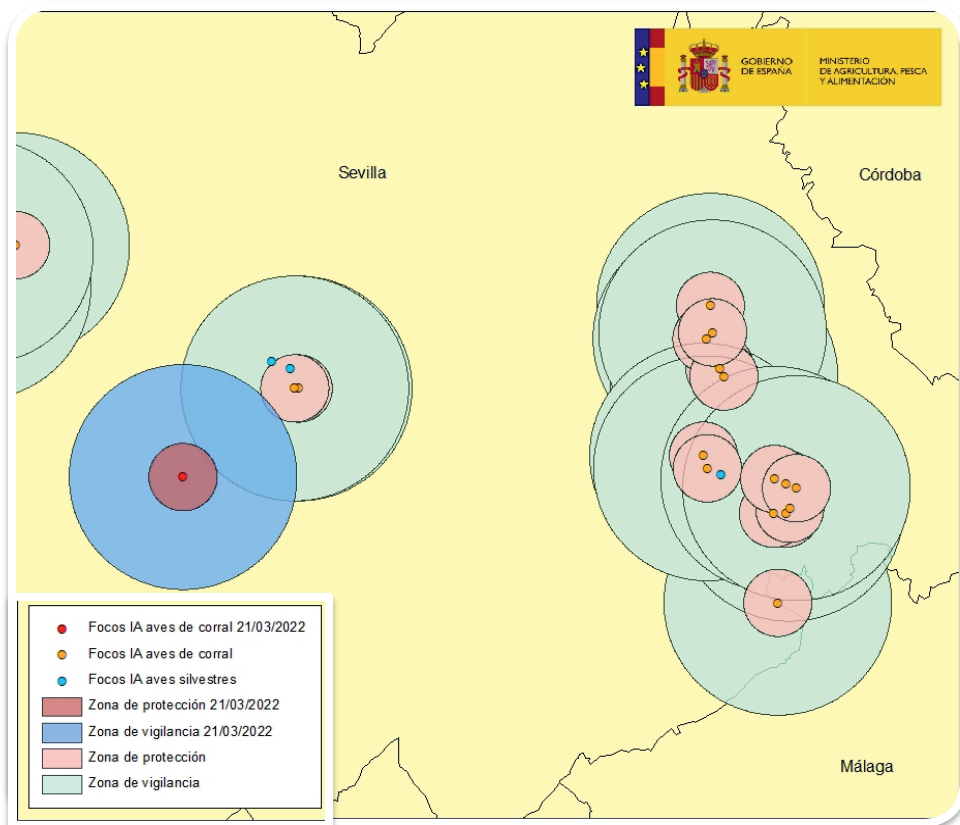

Additional measures “Intensified Surveillance Area”

Intensified Surveillance Area that covers Osuna- Écija- Marchena + Montilla (Córdoba) + some municipalities of Antequera (Málaga):

- Authorisation of the OVS and specific conditions for the movement of poultry both within and to/from this zone.
- Reinforcement of active and passive surveillance on poultry holdings in the area.
- Biosecurity controls on farms, with a questionnaire adapted to the disease according to EFSA opinion.
- Reinforced controls on cleaning and disinfection of transport vehicles operating in poultry farms in the area.
- Authorisation of restocking by the SVO on the basis of a risk analysis based on bird densities, distances and biosecurity on farms.

* Additionally, farms within RZ are being voluntarily emptied with the collaboration of the Sector in order to reduce the density of birds in the area.



Conclusions

- Epidemiological links: Possible contact with infected wild birds, Geographical proximity + high density area, Indirect contacts with previous outbreaks (shared transport vehicles or personal contacts- Same operator); Same owner 1 case.

- Three areas already lifted (Cantalejo, Huelva and Carmona)

- Previsions RZ lifting :
 - ✓ Íscar (16/04)
 - ✓ Osuna-Écija (2/05)
 - ✓ Marchena (23/04)
