



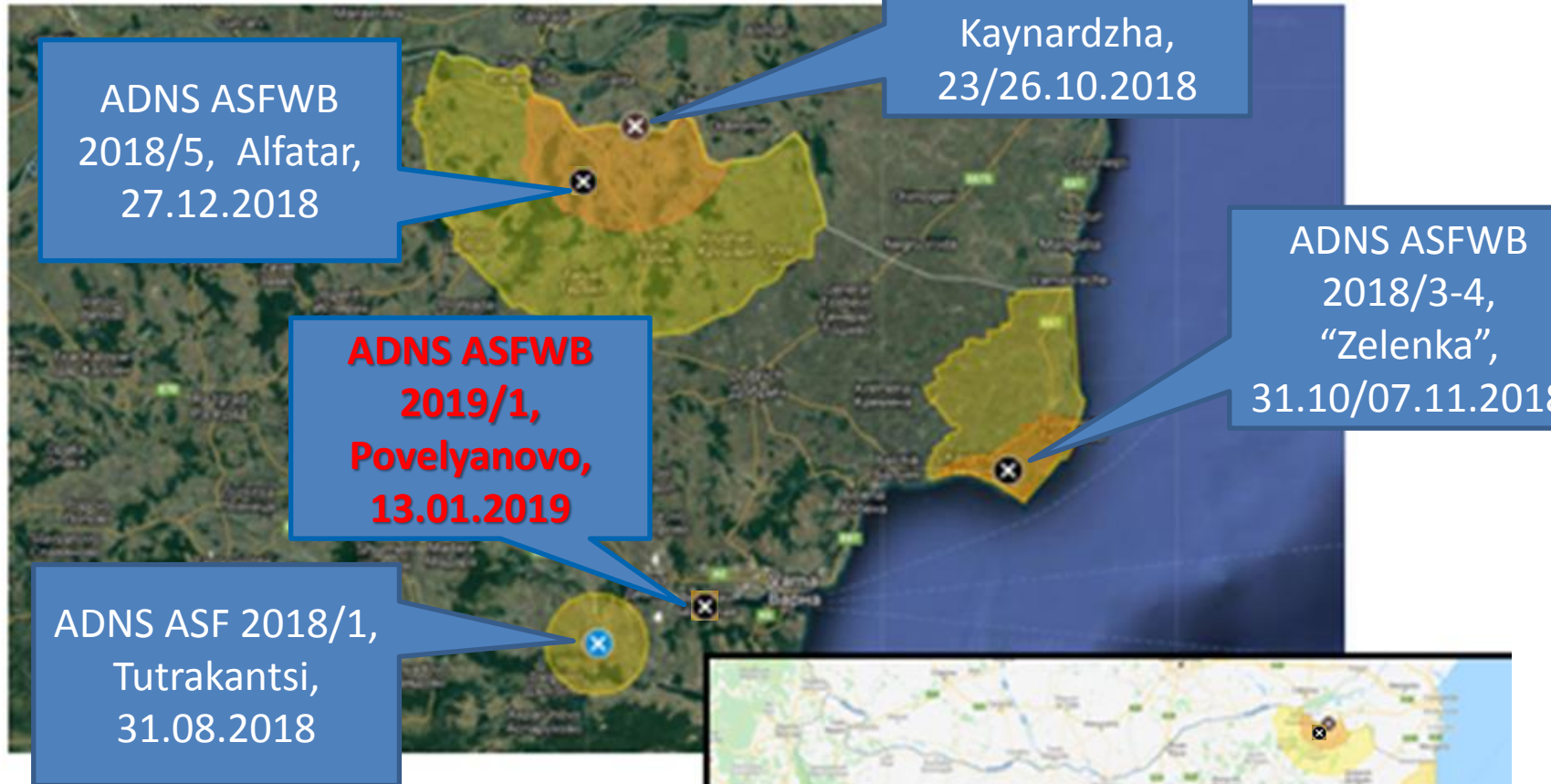

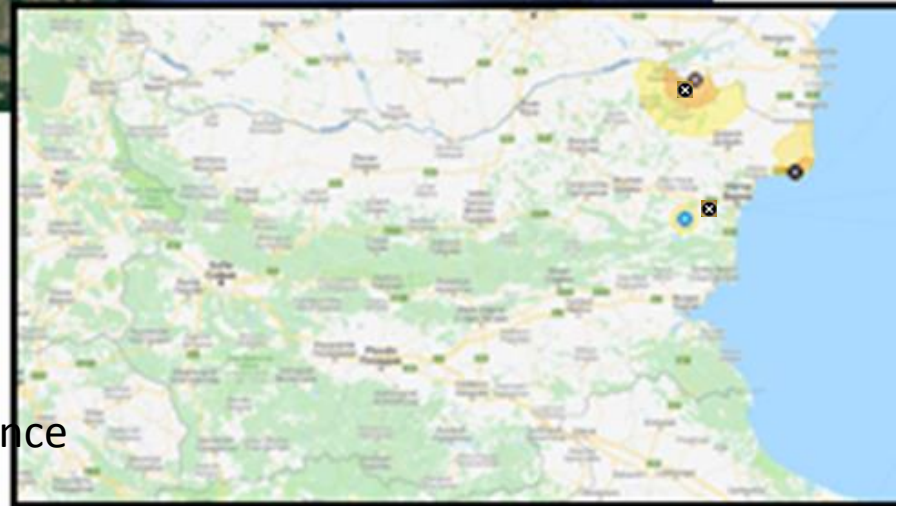
Overview of the epi-situation



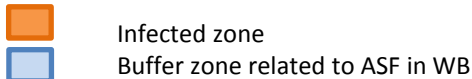
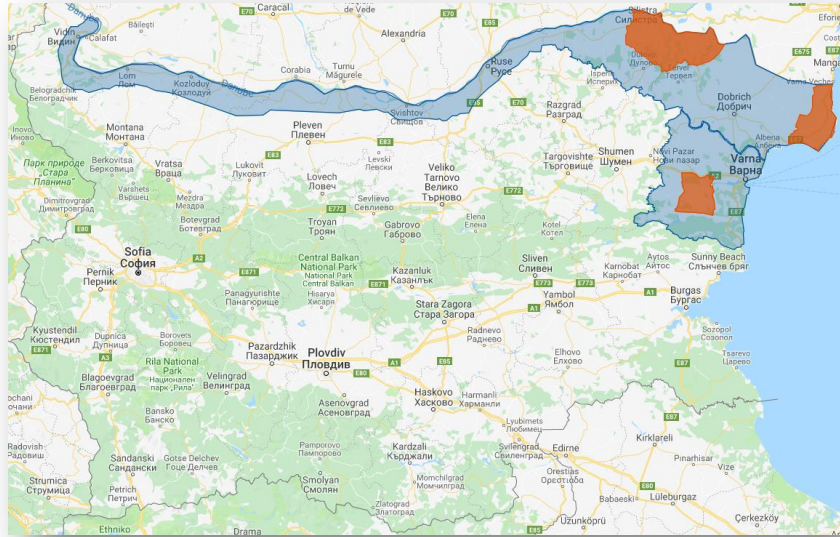
Infected zone

ASF in WB – Povelyanovo, Devnya, Varna region

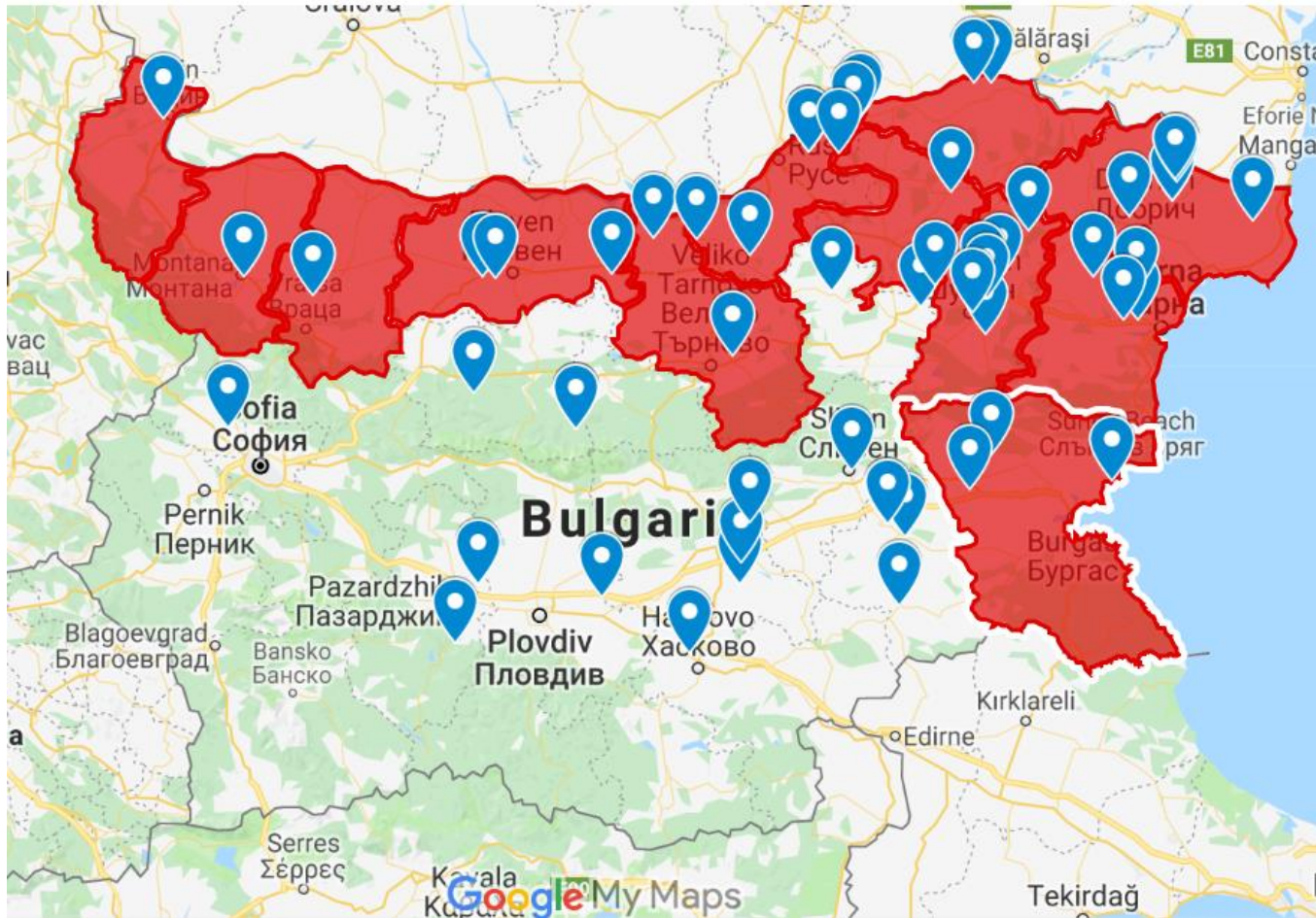


13.02.2019 - ASF in WB found dead in “Phasanaria” area, Povelyanovo, Devnya municipality, Varna region

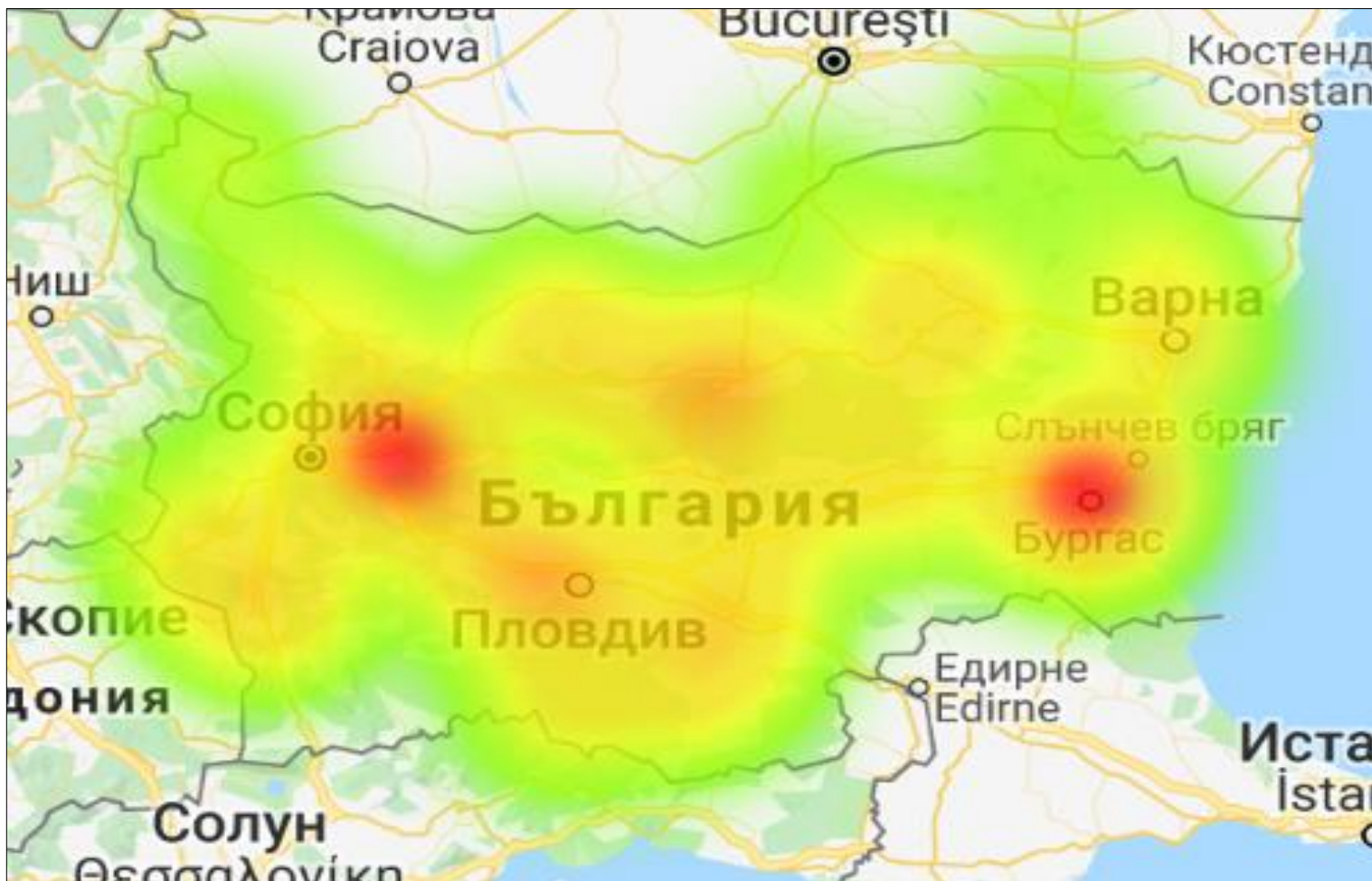
Restrictive zones established:

- Infected zone of 20 km radius around the case
- Buffer zone – merged with buffer zones of Dobrich and Silistra region

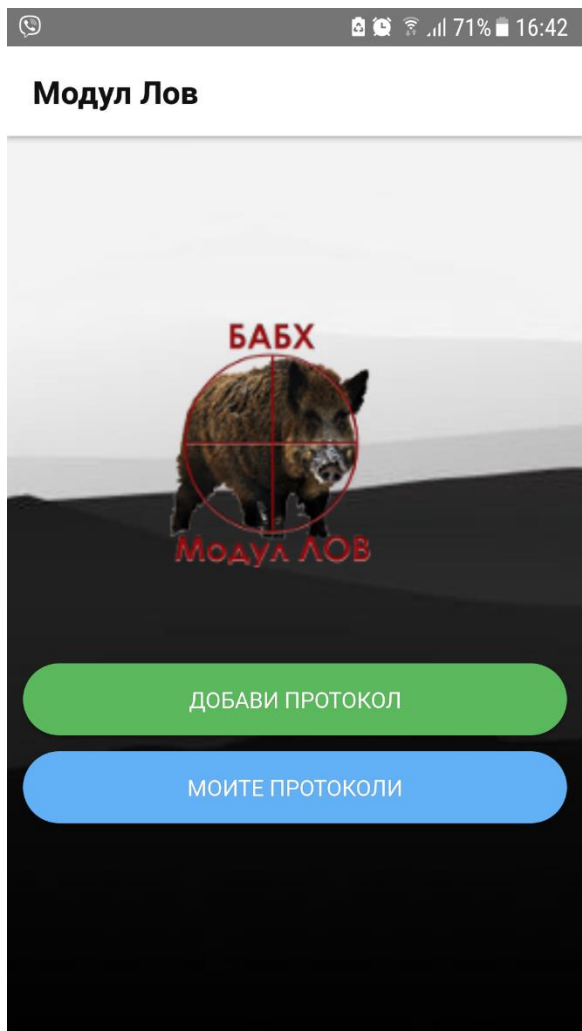
- **Measures related to hunt in the infected zones**
 - *Within 2 month following the confirmation of ASF case(s)*
 - *Two months following the confirmation of ASF case(s) and no further cases confirmed*
 - *Four months following the confirmation of ASF case(s) and no further cases confirmed*
- **Measures related to hunt in the buffer zones**
- **Measures related to domestic pigs in infected and buffer zones**

Measures applicable on the territory of the whole country

- ***Domestic pigs***
- ***Wild boar and hunting***
- ***General measures***

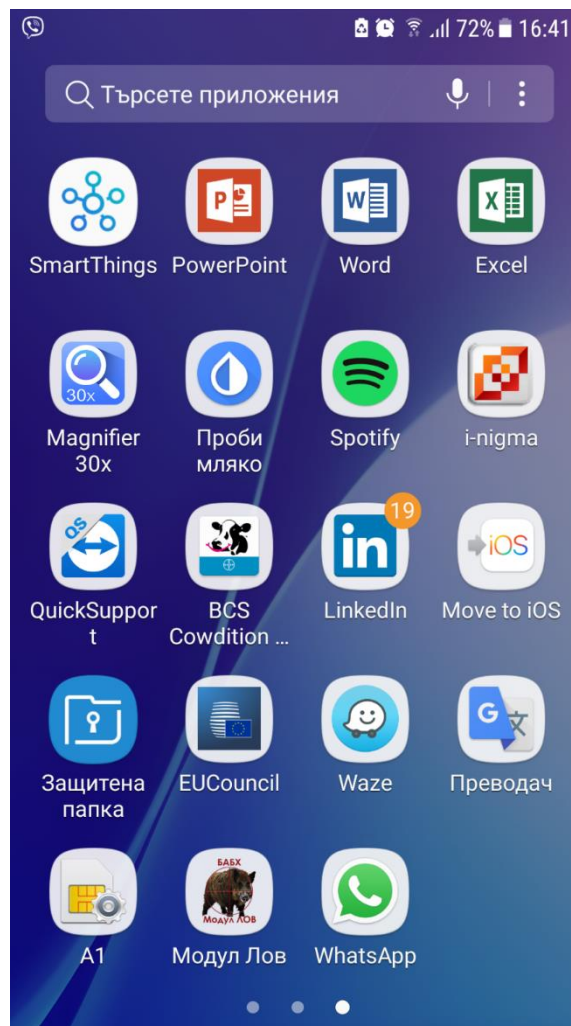
