






BTSF – seminars & conference


- Five seminars and one conference under the Better Training for Safer Food initiative within the indicative timeframe included between May 2020 September 2020 and April 2021;
- Seminars arriving lunch time day 1 and finishing in the afternoon of day 2;
- Conference on 21 April 2021.



Number of delegates

Seminars

- 60 participants each (MSs, EFTA);
- 300 participants to be trained of distributed over the five seminars.
- Conference (MSs, EFTA & Third Countries)
 - 100-150 participants.



Agenda

- General AHL rules and requirements (including the list of diseases and categories of diseases);
- Specific rules for the keeping and movements of animals in the EU (terrestrial and aquatic);
- Specific rules for movements of germinal products in the EU;
- Specific rules on disease prevention and control measures, including biosecurity, surveillance, eradication programmes, etc.;
- Specific rules for entry into EU of animals, products of animal origin and germinal products.














BTSF workshops

BTSF workshops


- **10 four-day training courses** in three or more appropriate EU locations;
- Addressed to...
 - officials from relevant competent authorities involved in policy making, planning and control activities (at central or regional level), and
 - field inspectors involved in such control activities, including border control post staff;
 - 30 people/workshop total number of 300;
 - MSs, EFTA and candidate countries.


Objective

- spreading knowledge, disseminating best practices for official policies and controls in the animal health area;
- favouring exchange of experience: increase the level of expertise and the level of consistency of their implementation across the EU.










e-learning

- The modules will be available from anywhere and at any time allowing participants who will normally be working full time to take advantage of webbased learning.









BTSF e-learning modular proposal

















Summary
