### AGENDA OF THE EU PREPARATORY MEETING ON 17 FEBRUARY FOR THE WTO SANITARY AND PHYTOSANITARY COMMITTEE OF MARCH 2014

The meeting will prepare the 59<sup>th</sup> regular meeting of the WTO Committee on Sanitary and Phytosanitary measures (SPS Committee) that will take place at the Centre William Rappard, Geneva on the **25-26<sup>th</sup> March 2014**. An informal meeting on private standards and possibly one other on the Fourth Review are provisionally scheduled for 24 March.

At the preparatory meeting on the 17<sup>th</sup> of February, the European Commission (COM) intends to discuss with Member States (MS) the main points of the agenda of the next SPS Committee. At this stage, only the preliminary agenda is available. The final, official agenda will be circulated by the WTO Secretariat on the 14<sup>th</sup> of March 2014 via the official WTO airgram.
