




France: HPAI confirmed on 24/11/2015 - last outbreak on 18/04/2016






Zones under restrictions





Gradual lifting of measures in zones under restrictions




Italy - HPAI H7N7 in Emilia Romagna

- *02/05/2016:*
 - organic free-range laying hen holding (17,000) in Ferrara province
- 16/05/2016:
 - meat turkey holding (~50,000) within the protection zone of first outbreak

Epidemiological investigations

- Possible introduction of low pathogenic virus through direct contact between wild birds and freerange laying hens
- Likely mutation from low to highly pathogenic strain - both were detected






Control measures at national level

Densely Populated Poultry Areas

- testing of all layer holdings
- pre-moving testing of pullets and laying hens
- pre-moving testing of fattening turkeys before loading for slaughter
- enhanced biosecurity measures
- functional separation of production between Emilia Romagna and other regions




<u>Lumpy skin disease (LSD) situation in 2013 - 2015</u> Disease spread






LSD situation in 2015: Greece (Aug-Dec 2015)

EU Lumpy Skin Disease vaccine bank

Created on April 2016 to support the initial stages of a vaccination campaign against LSD in an EU MS or neighboring non EU Member country:

Vaccines provided so far to:

Bulgaria : 150.000 doses (26 April 2016)

<u>Greece</u>: 50.000 doses (27 April 2016)

The Former Yugoslav Rep. of Macedonia: 50.000 doses (22 May 2016)

Remainder: 150.000 doses

Expansion: 200.000 doses (in the next weeks)

New tender: (to be launched in the following weeks)




Observations – Conclusions so far

- > LSD is a cross boundary disease requiring regional cooperation and coordination
- ➤ In most cases high vaccination coverage may be needed to stop disease spread / recurrence in the following year
- ➤ MS must be "generous" when defining LSD restricted / vaccination zones as the disease spreads unexpectedly over long distances in a unpredictable fashion.
- > Strict implementation of restrictions in the LSD restricted /vaccination zones is an important factor in preventing disease spread.
- Countries at risk should start making all preparations for emergency vaccination against LSD as the epidemic is in progress and spread may continue until December (as the case was in 2015 in Greece)




The result of the EU animal disease management African swine fever (ASF) well contained








The result of the EU animal disease management African swine fever (ASF) well contained










The result of the EU animal disease management ASF well contained








ASF regionalisation as per CID 2014/709/EC
