


ASF – SN: confirmed cases 2023







ASF – SN: Monitoring November 2023



- ASF cases found between double fenced white zone (WZ) and the border
- WZ aim to reduce wildboar population to 0,2 / 100ha
- weekly searches by drones and dogs to monitor and remove dead or sick animals



ASF – SN: Carcass Searches






ASF – SN: Fences in RZ I and RZ II

Under construction 100 km











ASF: Free communities

The protection of kept pigs and the protection of the related pig production sector from ASF

The control of ASF in the wild boar population to prevent significant pain, suffering and damage in wild boar and kept pigs

The prevention of the introduction and spread of ASF into the wild boar population in disease-free areas.

Priorities


- Sustainable management and riskorientated reduction of the wild boar population by increasing the hunting efforts
- Proper removal/disposal of wild boar carcasses
- maintaining/increasing biosecurity when handling wild boar and kept pigs
- Early detection and monitoring of the disease
- Controlling and eradicating of ASF in the infected areas










Hunting Bag: geographical overview










Hunting rules and changes

- Lifting of closed season for wild boar. Year-round hunting with a special focus
 on the subadult and adult females and overall the younger age groups
- Changes in the local legal framework to allow night aiming/vision devices for hunting wild boars
- Use of traps
- creation of hunting corridors (subsidy law)
- Use of drones with thermal imagine cameras
- Financial incentives to increase the wild boar reduction






