The scope and objective of the subgroup

• Policy indicators on animal welfare



- Pigs, broilers, laying hens, cattle, sheep and goats, rabbits and fish
- Only farming
- To measure the **effectivness of EU policy** instruments in delivering welfare to the animals



Main task

• Propose at least 3 indicators per specie that would be:



- the most effective to measure progress towards <u>the</u>
 <u>current EU animal welfare policy objectives</u>;
- the most effective to measure progress towards <u>the</u> <u>future EU animal welfare policy objectives</u>;
- feasible to collect, consolidate and interpret.



Process



- Identifying of the most relevant policy indicators
- Determining the methods to collect, consolidate and interpret those indicators for policy purposes
- Determining a methodology to measure the **baseline** of those indicators
- Defining criteria of **feasability** to collect, consolidate and interpret those indicators

- Independent experts


