

ASF surveillance in Latvia

Wild boar

- •all dead /sick wild boar are tested for ASF using qRT-PCR (passive surveillance for whole country)
- •all hunted animals, using qRT-PCR and ELISA (Part 2 and Part 3)

Domestic pigs


- •Sampling in the case of suspicion (for whole country)
- •Clinical inspection at home slaughtering and sampling in case of suspicion (Part 1, 2, 3)
- •Sampling of pigs according to requirements to Commission Implementing Decision 2014/709/EU (trade of live animals or meat)

Active surveillance - the number of animals tested (25 June - 4 December)

Summary:

6 out of 20 tested meat product samples found PCR positive on ASF virus

Meat and meat products: 29 066,02 kg

Milk and milk products: 18 618,51 kg
