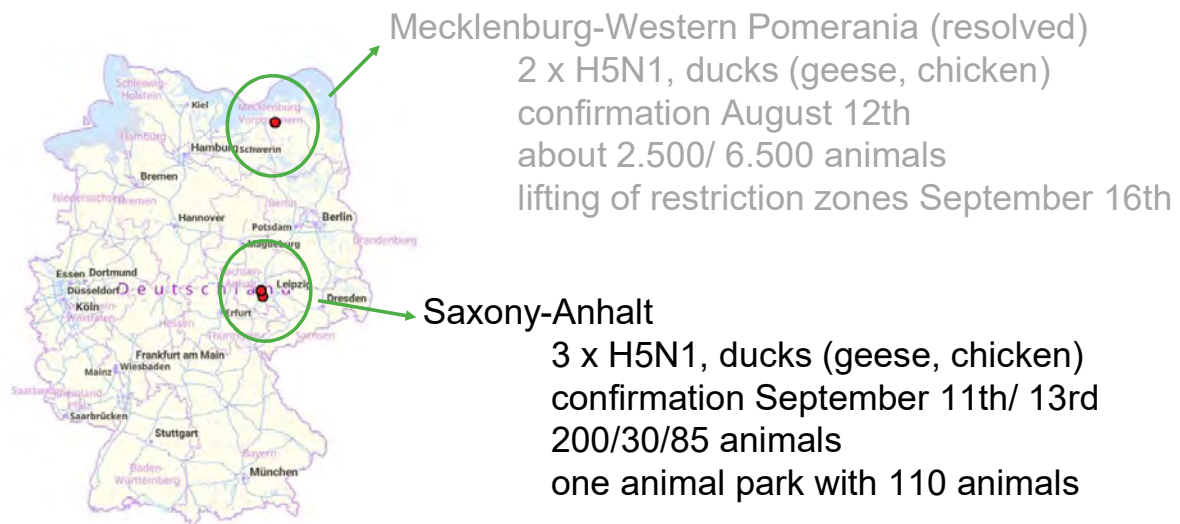

HPAI-situation in poultry and captive birds in 2024

Period of time	Number of outbreaks
Active outbreaks on 19/09/24	4
New from July 2024 (~last PAFF) until 19/09/2024	6 Zoo: 1 Poultry: 5 NON-Poultry: 0
total number of cases in 2024	23



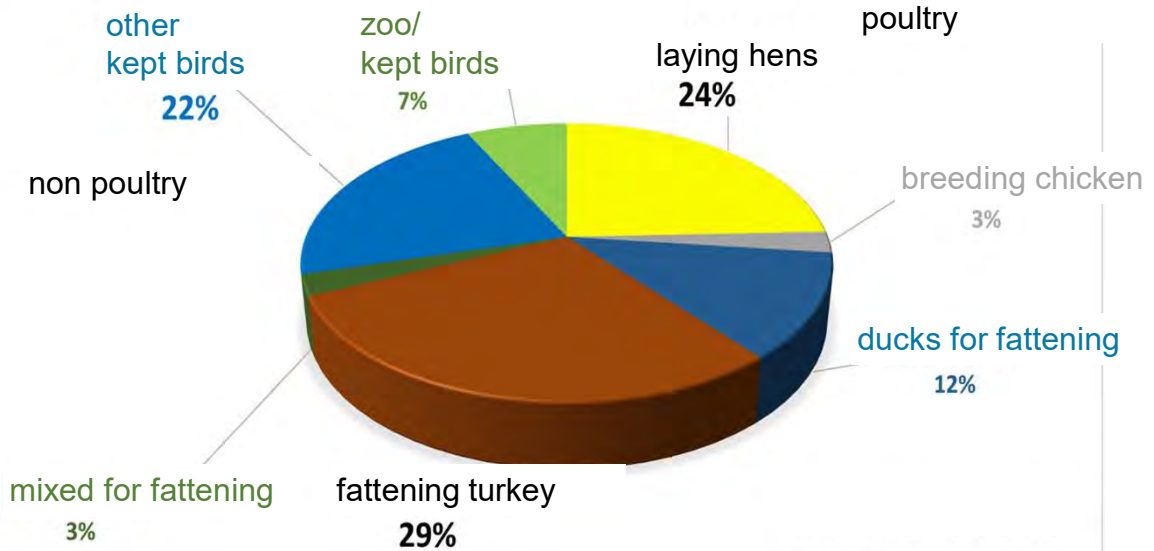
new HPAI-cases in poultry and captive birds since July 2024



measures by the competent authorities in Saxony-Anhalt

- ✓ establishment of confluent restriction zones (protection zone/ surveillance zone) for the three poultry holdings
- ✓ killing and safe disposal of all susceptible animals in affected poultry holdings as well as in the zoo
- ✓ cleaning and disinfection
- ✓ prohibition of bird markets, exhibitions (Kreis level)
- ✓ limitation of access for visitors (zoo)
- ✓ compulsory inhouse holding of captive birds around the affected holdings (radius 3 km)

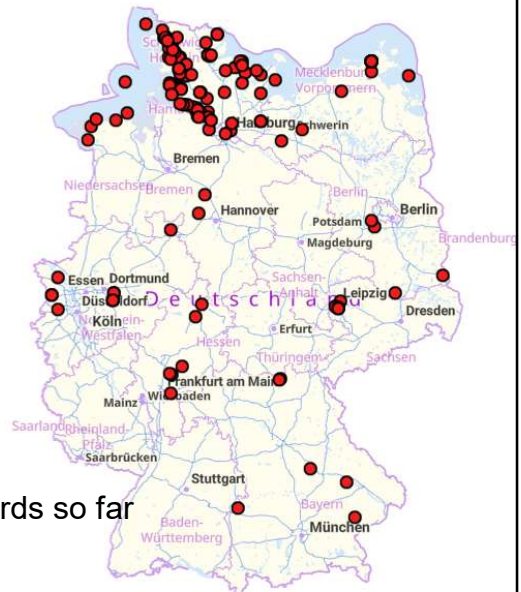
Establishments: Poultry and captive birds (2024)

Moderate level of HPAI cases in wild birds, mainly wild goose are affected
