

The OECD definition:

"A collaboratively agreed, self-determined pact to take action, on food waste generated at the relevant stages of the food system."



### How WRAP's VAs work?









TARGET	MEASURE	ACT
Set a goal that aligns with SDG Target 12.3 to halve FLW by 2030.	Measure FLW to understand how much, where and why it is occurring. Monitor progress and report.	Start implementing practices, programmes and policies to reduce FLW.





## How are we doing on reducing FLW?













#### **UK Households and Business: 2018**

- 31% less per capita household
- 13% less per capita businesses-
- by 2018- 2020, 250,000 t more businesses saving Euro 1.1 m/day


27% less per capita Overall: 2007 - 2018

- 1.7 Mt/y reduction
- 19Mt less cumulative
- £4.7bn/y saved
- £38bn saved cumulative

 Net 64Mt CO<sub>2</sub>e avoided from food not wasted
