Latest amendment to Regulation (EU) 2021/404

Outbreaks in CA, UK and US (10/2022)

UK (GB)

- 1st regionalised outbreak:
 2/11/2021
- Zones regionalised: 187 (+17 today)
- Zones reopened: 111 (+1 today)
- Birds affected: 4,1 millions
- Mainly affected areas: Lincolnshire and Norfolk (2 million birds)
- Mainly affected type of poultry: laying hens (2.16 million)


USA


- 1st regionalised outbreak: 8/2/2022
- Zones regionalised: 302 (+10 today)
- Zones reopened: 173 (+71 today)
- Birds affected: 46,2 millions
- Mainly affected areas: Iowa (13.4 million birds)
- Mainly affected type of poultry: laying hens (34.6 million)

Canada

- 1st regionalised outbreak:
 1/2/2022
- Zones regionalised: 103
- Zones reopened: 45
- Birds affected: 2.8 millions
- Mainly affected areas: Alberta (1.33 millions)
- Mainly affected type of poultry: breeder broiler (594,000)







Latest amendment of Regulation 2021/404 (plan 50U)

This amendment plans to lift restrictions on

- 1 zone in the UK: Orkney Islands, Scotland
- 71 zones in the US: States of Colorado (1), Delaware (2), Indiana (1), Iowa (3), Kansas (1), Maryland (3), Michigan (1), Minnesota (31), Missouri (2), North Carolina (9), North Dakota (1), Pennsylvania (11), South Dakota (1) and Wisconsin (4)

And implement restrictions on:

- 17 zones in the UK: (counties of Norfolk (11), Essex (3), Somerset (1), Lincolnshire (1) in England, and on the Isle of Lewis (1), Scotland
- 10 zones in the US (States of Colorado (1), Kentucky (1), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (1), South Dakota (3) and Utah (2)
