Comments column 1:

number of inspections are not recorded for animals for slaughter because it is the animals that are inspected. The number of inspections includes random and targeted checks at slaughterhouses, assembly centres and departures of animals from holdings.

number of animals sent for slaughter are all checked on arrival + the number of animals checked prior to export or intra community trade. For poultry it is only the number of animals for slaughter because poultry for intracommunity trade are not certified for fitness for transport

means of transport are not inspected in this relation to normal ante mortem checks. The number includes the number of vehicles inspection in relation to random and targeted checks.

documents: check of documents are not recorded for animals for slaughter in this relation to normal ante mortem checks. The number includes the number of documents inspected in relation to random and targeted checks. One document check represents all the documents for one consignment

Column 2:

Number of random checks during transport carried out by the police.

Column 3:

The inspections of journey logs after completion of the journeys including SNS data
