
BG-HPAI(P)-2022-00004 — Brod village, Haskovo region

- Asenovgrad town, Asenovgrad municipality, region of Plovdiv (BG-HPAI(P)-2022-00005).
- Suspicion on 25.03.2022 (increased mortality 150 dead poultry in 1 premises)
- Confirmation on 25.03.2022
- Eradication is on going, expected end data is 10.04.2022
- A primary outbreak of HPAI H5 N1
- laying hen farm with 177 440 laying hens kept in 4 premises.
- Restriction zones established 1 farm with 4900 mulard duck in 3 km zone, and 2 farms with 40000 mulard ducks in 10 km zone.

Further measures applied:

- Ban for outdoor poultry keeping;
- > Ban for poultry market;
- Enhanced biosecurity measures in the poultry farms;
- > Laboratory surveillance of the commercial farms located in the surveillance zone in Plovdiv region;
- Enhanced surveillance in wild birds in entire country;
- Further restriction zones to be established (under consideration);
- Awareness-raising and information-spreading:
- commitment by the local authority (regional epizootic commissions ensuring increasing the preparedness, capacity of the municipality and awareness among stakeholders)
 - meetings with representatives of the poultry industry.
- > Epidemiological investigations still ongoing in Plovdiv region;
- Higher interest in vaccination expressed by the poultry industry (preventive vaccination)
