Action plan and analysis of the annual reports for 2007 and 2008 on the protection of animals during transport (1/2005/EC)

2007

According to the data of Hungary's annual report for 2007 on the protection of animals during transport (1/2005/EC) most of the infringements were detected at the place of departure so the anomalies could be corrected. Several deficiencies were experienced at the place of destination, as well. The number of infringements might be resulted from the fact that the new legislation came into force only in the January of 2007, and transporters were not fully prepared to apply the new provisions and they had to get familiar with the new requirements.



Some feedbacks were received from other Member States' competent authorities which inform us about that some transport companies did not send back the journey logs. A few problems arose from the inappropriate water supply, inadequate partitions and that the temperature registration system did not work properly. The attention of the regional veterinary authorities has been already drawn to these problems in a circular letter issued by the central competent authority.

2008

The summary report for the year 2008 shows similar data and ratios. The percentage of infringements per inspections remains under 1% almost in every field.

Having summarized the experiences - due to the lack of serious infringements - it did not seem necessary to take any particular, national actions. As the veterinarians have more possibility to prevent the infringements related to transport at the place of loading, we are going to put more emphasis on these checks, especially on the documentary checks, the adequate issuing of the journey logs and the control of means of transport.
