1. ANALYSIS OF THE MAJOR DEFICIENCIES DETECTED DURING THE NON-DISCRIMINATORY INSPECTIONS

For the purpose of this annual report, the following have been considered to be major deficiencies:

- 1.1. Non-realistic journey plans for long distance journeys waiting times on borders to third countries;
- 1.2. Not sufficient condition of some animals (not fit for transport-pregnant animals);
- 1.3. Lack of litter in vehicle for long distance journey;
- 1.4. Some technical problems on vehicles (not working fans or control lightning).

2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED UNDER POINT 1.

- 2.1. On meetings with local level officials is pointed out, that allways they must control journey plans before loading of animals with relevant websites (Google maps, Via Michelin), given to officials contacts with Bulgaria Turkey border vet services.
- 2.2. Information about how to assess animals fitness for transport was sended to local officials. They are recommended to assess animals condition before I
