A FLW reporting initiative centred around 5 main objectives

A global FLW reporting based on on-site measurements

- Build trust and move way from pure marketing / communication purpose.
- · Set reliability criteria

Define a common scope and methodology

- Include all food (edible and non edible) but not beverage
- · Measure form preparation (kitchen) to plate waste
- On-site measurement only
- Minimum campaign of 5 days.

Agree on metric

Set targets

- Expand on site measurements: 1000 sites in 2022
- Improve data reliability: 65% in 2022

Over 780 reporting sites using common KPIs and methodology

- +20% reporting sites since 2020
- Started including hospitality
- Enlarged geographic spread




Reporting sites





Measured FLW reduction by over 20% in average since 2019

- Strong improvement in 2020 continued in 2021
- Impact of the pandemic still need to be further explored
- Corporate segments is showing the strongest improvement




