

ASF Outbreaks in kept porcine animals in 2022











Epidemiological information on outbreakes




- All outbreaks in ASF affected areas (Infected wild boar in ~5 km or closer).
- Summer (harvesting) period.
- Suspicions were reported by the farmers and during enhanced passive surveillance.
- No direct contacts with wild boar were identified







Wild porcine animal cases in 2022 (till 12th September)



In total **806** ASF cases in wild porcine animals (347 hunted, 459 found dead) ASF virus positive 601 cases, seropositive 205 cases




Competent authorities:

- Food and Veterinary service (FVS)
- State Forest service (SFS)

Till 1st April 2022: wild boar was limited hunted animal. SFS determines limit (theoretical maximum).

Since 1st April – SFS determines the minimum number of hunted wild boar.

- Data base of all hunted wild boar (age, sex, date, area)
- Identification of all hunted wild boar
- Sampling, testing and storage of hunted wild boar (active surveillance)
- Passive surveillance

Incentives for reporting of found dead wild boar.





Regulation of the Cabinet of Ministers No 1483 «Rules for feeding wild game animals» (17.12.2013.)

- Sustained feeding of wild boar is prohibited.
- Baiting (non-sustained feeding, limited food only) for attracting wild boar for hunting, not exceed 10kg/km2/month).



Regulation of the Cabinet of Ministers No. 226 «Regulation on the complex of biosecurity during hunting» (19.04.2018).

Cover - wild boar hunting and handling (self consumption).

- Disinfection
- Minimums requirements for the processing place.
- Storage place (no risk for domestic pigs).
- Safe storage and disposal of ABP.
