



Onward transportation - Article 51.1 (a)

The current provisions set out in Reg. (EC) No 669/2009 are under evaluation:

- Notification by BCP of first arrival to the competent authority at the place of destination
- Arrangements put in place to ensure controls of consignments
- Authenticated paper/electronic copy of CHED to be issued for the consignment





Transhipment of animals and animal origin products - Article 51.1 (b)(c)

Existing requirements for checks of transhipped consignments of live animals and PAO proposed to be maintained

The modifications envisaged in Delegated Act:

- Time limit for PAO consignments to be discussed
- Original/copied documents presented for documentary checks to be discussed





Transit of animals/ animal origin products - Article 51.1 (d)

Current requirements proposed to be maintained Intention to clarify certain provisions that create difficulties to implement existing legislation:

- Procedures that can be taken by BCPs/CA in cases where TC consignments transiting EU are rejected by TC of destination
- Provisions for CA/BCPs or operators in cases where means of transport is changed (after rejected by TC)
- Transfer of consignments between customs warehouses to be discussed
- Provisions especially dedicated to NATO bases to be discussed
- Specific provisions on ship supplying to be discussed

Specific requirements for transit from/to Kaliningrad region and from Bosnia Hercegovina to be integrated in control provisions



Transhipment / transit food and feed of non-animal origin - Article 51.1 (b)(c)(d)

Intention is to maintain existing requirements set out in Reg.(EC) No 669/2009 and extend the scope to transhipped consignments arriving by air

 Consignments arriving by sea/air and being transhipped to another vessel/airplane to be checked at BCP of final destination

No official control requirements for checks at BCPs for consignments in transit





Phytosanitary transit of plants, plant products and other objects - Article 51.1 (b)(c)(d)

Requirements for transit and transhipment (phytosanitary transit) stipulated in Art. 47 of Regulation 2016/2031:

- Consignments in phytosanitary transit shall be accompanied by a signed declaration of the professional operator
- Plants are packed and moved in such a way that there is no risks of spreading of Union quarantine pests
- Documentary checks at BCPs 100%





Derogation from rules on identity and physical checks for transhipped/transit consignments of plants, plant products - Article 51.1 (e)

The cases and conditions for consignments in transit which are specified in Dir.2004/103 proposed to be maintained





Derogation from rules on documentary checks for transhipped/transit consignments of plants, plant products - Article 51.2

According to Art.49, 54 of OCR all consignments referred in Article 47(1) shall be subject to documentary controls at BCPs

• It is not envisaged to use this provision
