Situation in **wild** birds

- Amount of cases up to **18/5/2021**:
1.317 cases
- **Serotypes detected:**
H5N8, -N5, -N4, -N3, -N1
Mainly H5N8



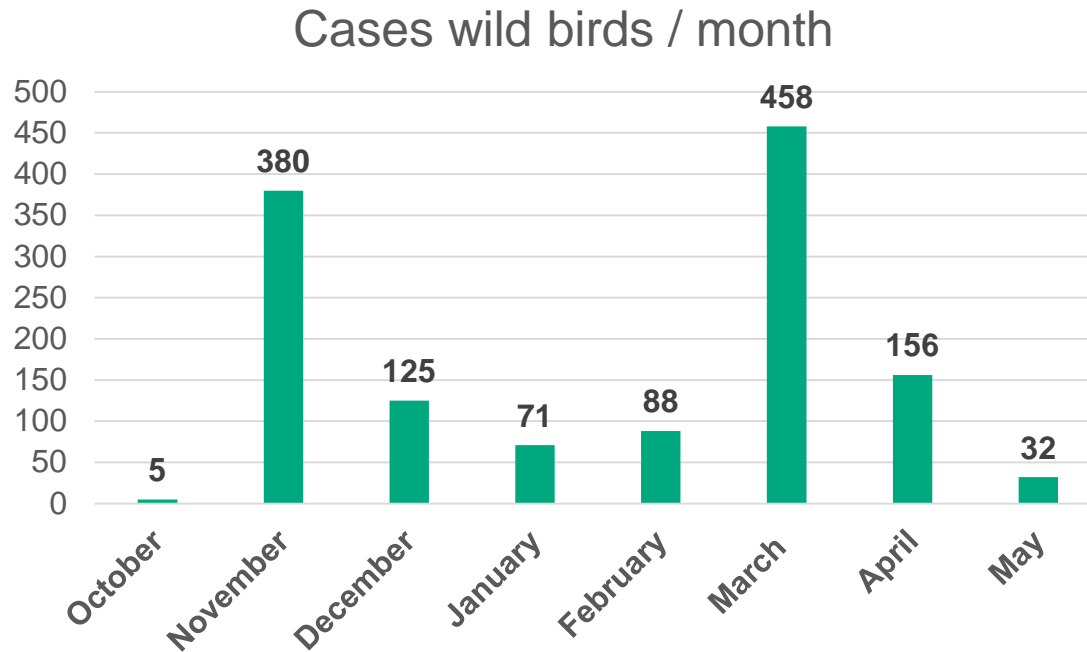
Period 1/- 18/5/2021: 32 new cases

Serotypes detected: H5N8 and H5N1



Situation in **wild** birds – EVOLUTION

The migration of wild birds is almost finished.



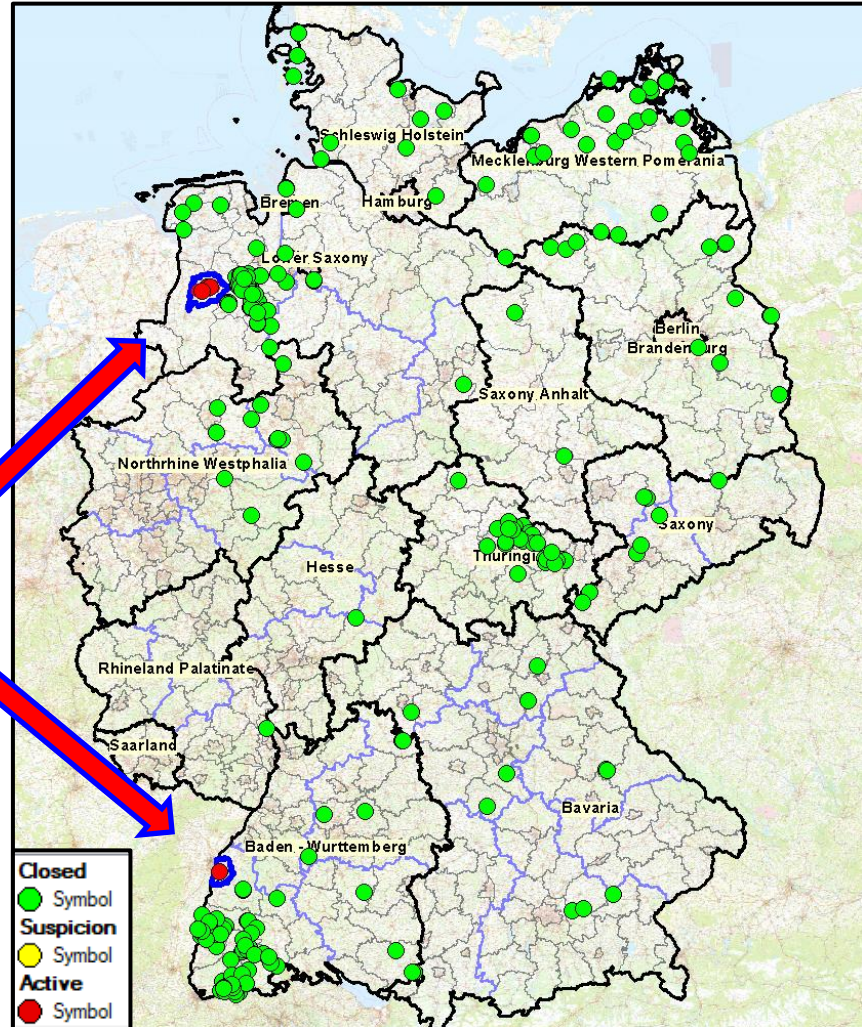
Captive birds poultry and non-poultry

Total confirmed: 257

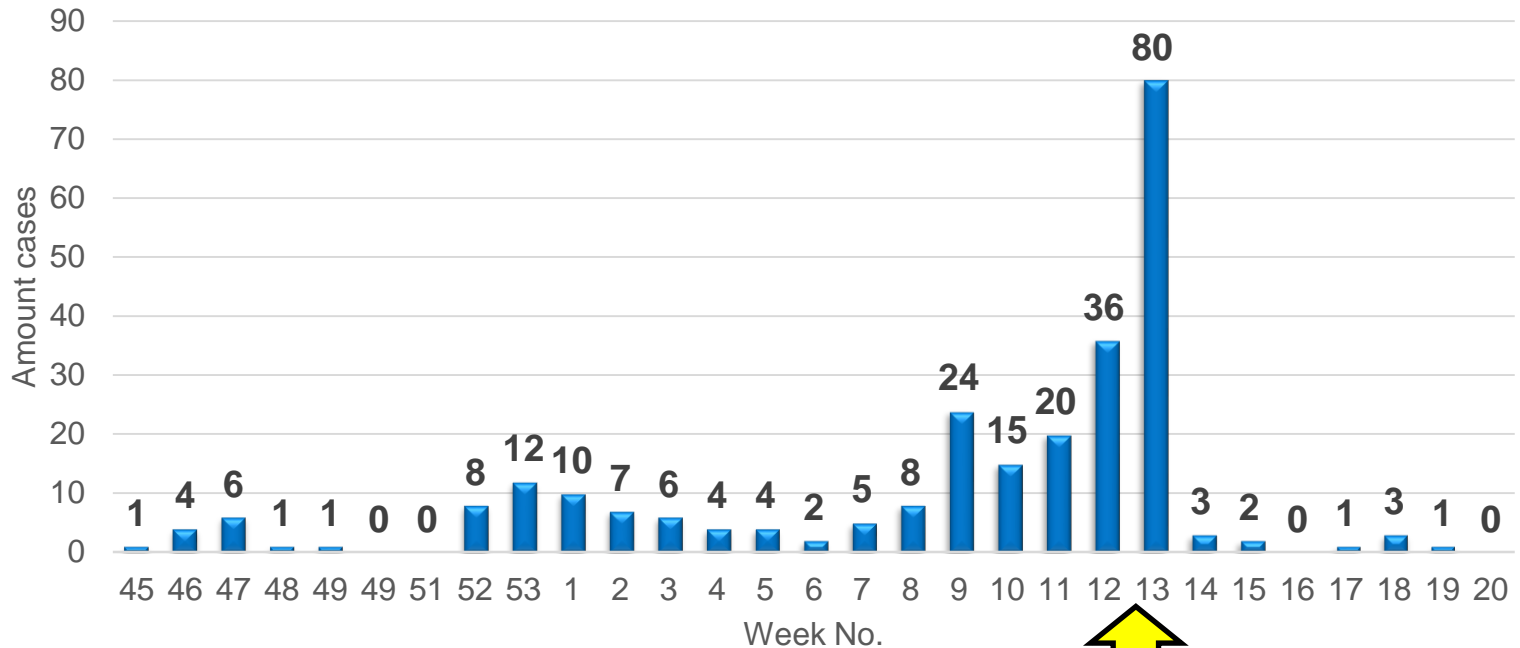
- active: 5.

Captive birds 30/10/2020 – 18/5/2021 poultry and non-poultry

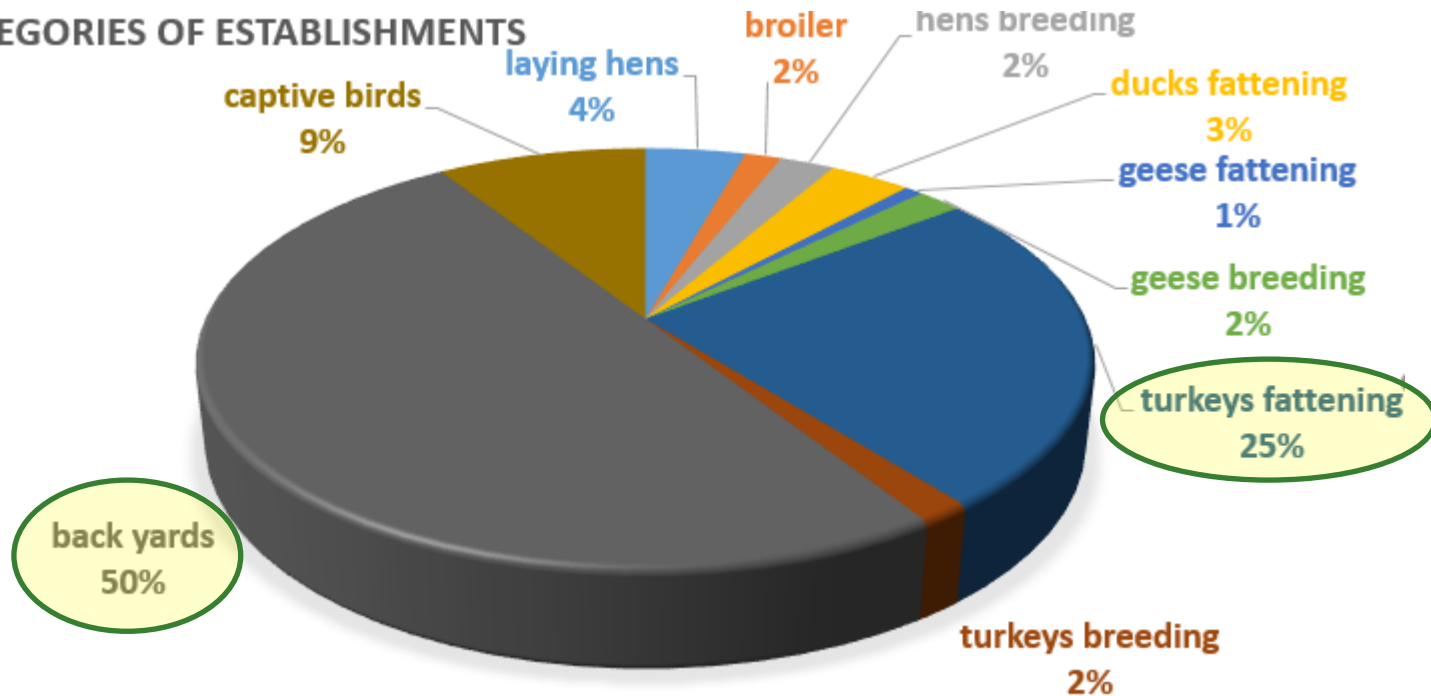
HPAI cases in captive birds poultry and non-poultry

Summary

1. The HPAI event 2020-2021 seems to have come to an end.
...hopefully
2. The migration of wild birds is almost finished.
The infection pressure posed by the wild bird population is definitively lower.
3. The **risk of occurrence** of HPAI was downgraded from high to **moderate** by Friedrich Loeffler Institute - Federal Research Centre for Animal Health)
4. Only 5 active outbreaks in poultry remained on 18/5/2021.
No new outbreaks in poultry since 10/5/2021.
5. “Lessons learned” assessment will follow in order to improve the prevention and the capacity of response.
