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# Implementing and delegated act for applying the EU plant health regime

- PLANT HEALTH REGULATION (EU) 2016/2031 +
- OFFICIAL CONTROLS REGULATION (EU) 2017/625
- All essential delegated and implementing acts are in place
- Complementary acts scheduled for 2021 (work done/on-going)



#### **High risk plants**

- Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/2019
- Receiving dossiers from non-EU countries to make the full risk assessment by April 2021: 48 dossiers received
- 44 accepted as 'complete' at COM level and 21 assessed by EFSA
- 9 finalised with
  - Implementing Regulations amending Regulation (EU) 2018/2019
  - Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/ 1213 + amendments with specific requirements for specified plants from specified countries

- Amendment Regulation (EU) 2020/1825 articles
- Amendment Regulation (EU) 2020/2210 and 2020/2211 techn annexes UK
- Technical revision 2021 under preparation:
  - Draft Commission Implementing Regulation
  - stakeholder / SPS consultation: August + September 2021
  - Last PAFF verification: 21-22 Oct 2021
  - Written procedure for vote: end Oct 2021
  - Finalisation translation + MS verification of translations: Nov 2021
  - Adoption and publication: Dec 2021
  - Entry into application: 3 months later

  - Stakeholder consultation: Dec 2021
  - Final consultation PAFF
  - Written procedure for vote: start Jan 2022
  - Finalisation + MS verification of translations Jan 2022
  - Adoption + publication: end Jan 2022
  - Entry into application: 3 days after publication

#### **EU Reference Laboratories**

- 5 EU Reference Laboratories for Plant Health
- National Reference Laboratories designated and published
- COM Delegated Regulation (EU) 2021/1353 of 17 May 2021 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2017/625 of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the cases and conditions under which competent authorities may designate official laboratories which do not fulfil the conditions in relation to all the methods they use for official controls or other official activities



#### Frequency of import checks

#### **Art.54.3 frequency of import checks**

Three years transitional period in order to collect data on IMSOC.

During that period Commission Regulation (EC) No 1756/2004 will be valid: frequencies 2021 in place (+ monitoring for FCM in roses from KE)

New approach from Dec 2022 to be prepared!
