Update on France situation



Update on the French situation 30/08/2017

- 1 farm was detected positive on the north of France on the 28/07 after using DEGA 16 :
 - Eggs were not put on the market
 - Eggs were destroyed
- The slaughter of poultry and destruction of meat was decided
- All French establishments who received contaminated eggs or egg products from Belgium and the Netherlands were named on the website of the French Ministry for agriculture and food :
 - 18 processing plants
 - 2 packaging centers
 - 40 wholesalers
- 32 products were withdrawn from the market (<ARfD). The public was warned of those withdrawn trough posters and the Ministry website

Management measures in farms

- IT 2017-667: A technical instruction was published on the 07/08 for the investigation (questionnaire and on site inspections) on farms regarding the use of:
 - DEGA 16 Cooper Boost
 - Antiparasitic currently used
- Other investigations :
 - 10 farms are been thoroughly investigated after a non compliant result was identified on egg products by the Belgian authorities
 - 19 farms are been investigated after using Amitraz during the fallowing period
- Management of contaminated poultry: slaughtered or maintened

Management measures in farms : partial results

- IT 2017-667: investigation on farms regarding the use of Antiparasitic, biocids, veterinary medicins: 47 products used against Dermanyssus gallinae: 3 veterinary medicine products (VMP = BYEMITER, MITEXR, TAKTICR), 21 Biocids (and only 14 with acaricid activity), 23 without status (a large part are plant based)
- Other investigations in case of usage of TAKTIC^R (amitraz): 19 farms concerned by a usage of this VMP as a biocid, so without the presence of hens
 - Sample of eggs and analysis for amitraz residus : no results for the moment
 - All samples already done to search Fipronil are negative on Amitraz residus.

Products management (1/2)

 IT 2017-701: A technical instruction was published for the management of products

Products management (2/2)

- Investigation on upstream traceability identification of incorporated raw material, if:
 - Eggs or egg products coming from Belgium or Netherlands
 - Identification of contaminated eggs or egg products
 - → Lab analysis or checking by calculation are made for processed products
- Investigation on downstream traceability identification of batches with contaminated raw material
 - → Lab analysis or checking by calculation to verify the compliance of the batch
- Control and survey plan at the retailer level

- Management of contaminated farms: becoming of poultry
- Management of by-products coming from egg shelling plant potentially contaminated

- Harmonization of veterinary practices in farms
