ASF – Epidemiological situation from 26. 6. 2017 to 31. 1. 2018


In total **217** cases of African swine fever in wild boar population

- The total number of positive cases found in dead wild boar: 200
- The total number of positive cases in hunted wild boar: 17

NO OUTBREAK IN DOMESTIC PIGS

Total number of ASF tested wild boar

- Part II: found dead 332 / 200 positive hunted 2522 / 17 positive
- Part I: found dead 73 / no positive hunted 6 168 / no positive
- Area with intensive hunting (without Part I and Part II) hunted 6433 / no positive

Total number of found dead wild boars from 1, 2, 2018 to 16, 4, 2018


New Part II: 84 / 9 positive

New Part I: 32 / no positive


Total number of hunted wild boars from 1. 2. 2018 to 16. 4. 2018

Map of the findings of dead wild boar in Part II from 1. 2. 2018




Map of the hunted wild boar in Part II from 1. 2. 2018




ASF – area with intensive hunting

Total number of hunted wild boar in area with intensive hunting:

until 31. 1. 2018 : 12 601



1. 2. – 16. 3. 2018: **2 602**



All ASF laboratory test negative



ASF - intensive search of cadavers in the infected area

The most serious risk of ASF spreading in the wild boar population are cadavers of dead wild boar.

The State Veterinary Administration has therefore ordered an intensive control of the infected area and collection of carcasses

The searching has been done by local hunting associations

40 dead wild boar were found and seven of them were ASF positive

- all cadavers were 3 to 5 months old.


These positive findings do not indicate the spread of ASF infection and possible **reduction**

of the risk for further spread.

ASF – measures in domestic pigs in Part II

- A list of pig farms with all categories of pigs was performed including backyards farm, the list shall be kept up-to-date.
- Ban of keeping of pigs in backyard farms in the risk zone in the infected area from March 12, 2018.
- Farmers must report all dead pigs in the breed in the infected area, ASF laboratory tests are performed.
- Movement of pigs only with authorisation issued by the RVA for Region Zlín.
- Official control in domestic pig farms continue in accordance with Commission Implementing Decision 2014/709/EU.
