ASF in Slovakia – state of play in wild bar population



Wild boar :

- cases found dead 2 new districts Rožňava, Rimavská Sobota in the areas already included in part II 2014/709/EC
- whole year 2020: 236 pozit. WB in 6 districts (Trebišov, Michalovce, Košice-okolie, Košice-city, Rožňava, Rimavská Sobota)
- In the period 14.7.-22.09.2020- 50 wb positive tested
- All cases/positive results within an area close to the SK/HU border south- east part of Slovakia

ASF in Slovakia – state of play in the period 14.07.-22.09.2020

Domestic pigs

15 outbreaks confirmed (ADNS 2020/2- 2020/ 16 ; last outbreak 04.09.2020;) first outbreak in 2020- on 10.7.2020 – ADNS 2020/1- information provided in July 2020

Data regarding 15 outbreaks:


- 2 small commercial holdings (together 601 pigs from that 35 sows)
- 13 backyard holdings with low number of pigs in the holdings
- All outbreaks reported via ADNS
- All holdings was located in the ASF infected area (in part II and part III 2014/709/EC)
- All measures according to Directive 2002/60/EC was implemented
- Restricted zone established (CID concerning certain protective measures related to ASF in Slovakia adopted by the EC)




The new outbreaks in domestic pigs 2020




- The epidemiological investigation in a positive holdings provided, the way of introduction of virus into the holding still under investigation-BUT! - low biosecurity level of holdings often in place ! (introduction via fomites)
- The census of pig farms done, all infected pig farms as a contact farms in the infected villages already depopulated and safely rendered.
- Measures ordered for ASF outbreaks and zones 3/10 km established
- New infected areas established (part III 2014/709/EC)
- From destroyed pigs (farms) blood samples taken




SK zoning (in September 2020)- the changes/ evolution within 1 year (left -2020, right -2019)




Outbreaks and zones established in Trebišov- summer 2020




Geographical distribution of samples submited for ASFV investigation in domestic swine in Slovakia during 2020 (January - August)




Geographical distribution of domestic swine samples positive for ASF virus in Slovakia during 2020 (January - August)




Laboratory Investigations of ASF in domestic pigs in Slovakia during 2020 (January - August)




Laboratory Investigations of ASF in domestic pigs in Slovakia during 2012 - 2020




Geographical distribution of samples submitted for ASFV investigation in wild boars in Slovakia during 2020 (January - August) - passive surveillance




Laboratory Investigations of ASF in wild boars in Slovakia during 2020 (January - August) - passive surveillance




Geographical distribution of samples submitted for ASFV investigation in wild boars in Slovakia during 2020 (January - August) - active surveillance








Laboratory Investigations of ASF in wild boars in Slovakia during 2012 - 2020




Laboratory Investigations of ASF in wild boars in Slovakia during 2020 (January - August) - passive surveillance - selected districts





Hunting WB-SK



Further valid actions ongoing



- Biosecurity checks very complicated tasks- first evaluation of check up to 1.9.2020 will be available at the beginning if October 2020 -process ongoing (described in SK ASF eradication programme)- PROBLEMS WITH UNDERSTANDING BY OWNERS/PIG HOLDERS
- practical vets involved directly into the public awareness campaigns
- Active /passive surveillance system in place for a long term
- Within passive surveillance (WB) active searching of carcasses ordered via extraordinary measures- especially in the new infected areas
- Intensive WB hunting in free areas the encouraging the hunters to do their job in order to decrease the WB population
- Special training courses regarding hunting management- planned from autumn 2020 a bit postponed due to COVID situation (trainings – a part of support and co-financing of EC)















Summary...

- Till 22.9.2020 no further suspicions in domestic pigs in that area KS??
- WB positivity in the area currently determined as a part II of 2014/709/EC
- Measures in accordance 2002/60/EC ordered
- Measures in accordance 2014/709/EC in place
- Backyard holdings often low biosecurity level noted/observed, possible introduction of the virus into the holding checks of biosecurity on the local level in progress- recommendation to stop pig breeding in infected areas and/or areas with high risk ! (non-commercial holdings)
