## **CSF monitoring program 2015**

- CSF monitoring program
  - Monitoring program in domestic pig population
  - Monitoring in wild boar population

## Monitoring program in domestic pig population

- Monitoring programme for pig holdings
  - Herd based sampling scheme to detect a 1% level of sero-positive herds with 95% confidence (149 pig herds) combined with the risk based approach
    - sampling in breeding herds
    - sampling in small breeding herds
    - investigation of fallen stock collected by VHS (Veterinary Hygienic Service) in regional units of NVI
  - Detection of within-herd prevalence of 5% with 95% confidence in breeding herds, also combined with risk based components
    - purchased breeding pigs
    - pigs with health problems

## Monitoring program in wild boar population


- Monitoring program in wildboar population
  - Random sampling
    - Minimum of 406 samples
  - Risk-based
    - found dead wild boars and road-kills

#### **Results of 2015 CSF monitoring programme**

- Monitoring in domestic pig population
  - Testing of randomly selected farms (ELISA)
    - 149 holdings /3.123 samples
    - All negative
  - Testing of fallen stock (PCR)
    - 189 holdings /298 samples
    - All negative

#### **Results of 2015 CSF monitoring programme**

- Monitoring in wild boar population
  - Random sampling
    - 432 samples
  - Risk-based samples
    - 20 samples fallen stock (PCR)
  - all negative



# **Financial aspect**

- Targets set in the approved programme for year
  2015 were achieved
- Grant Decision for 2015
  - approved 22.000 €
  - Eligible costs (amount claimed) 13.189,26 €
