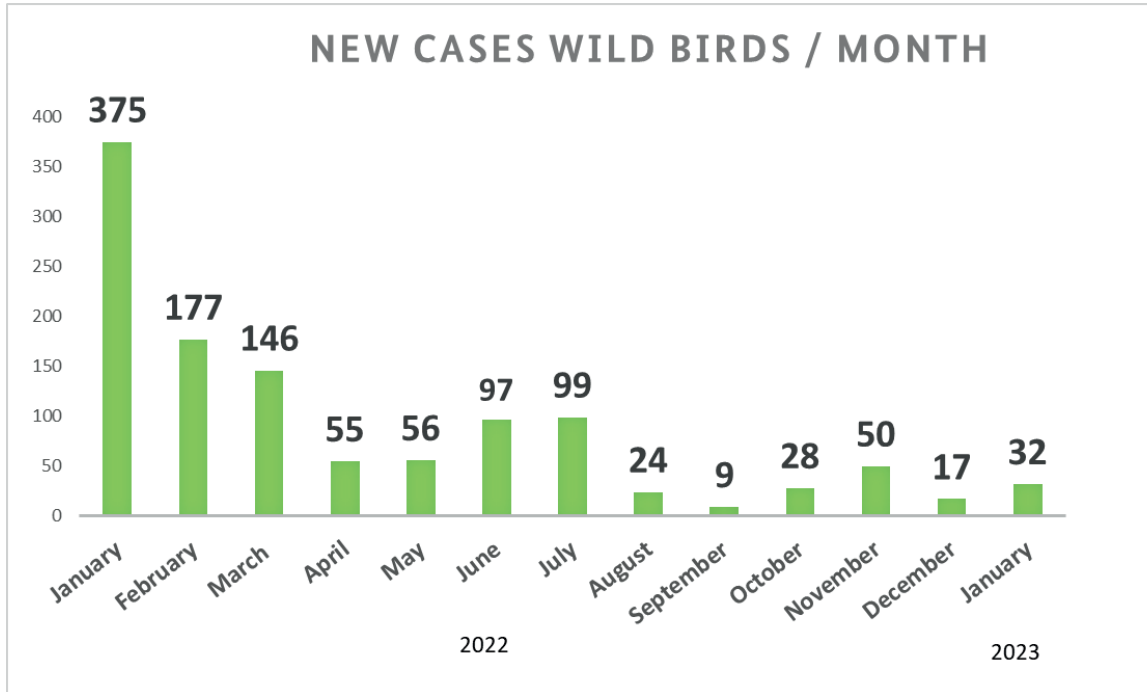

1. Evolution in wild birds



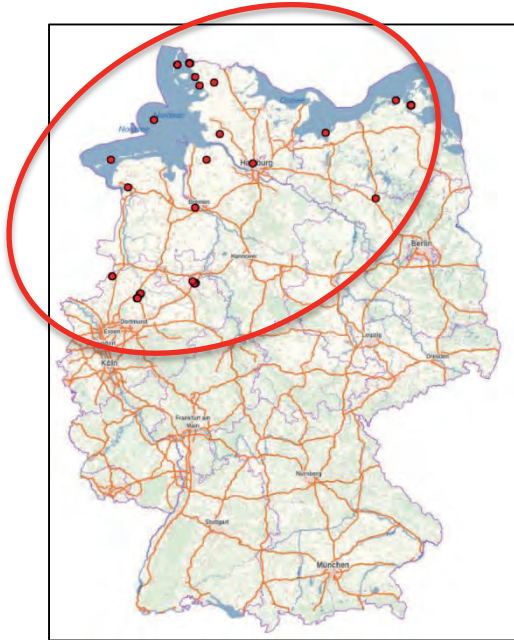

January 2023

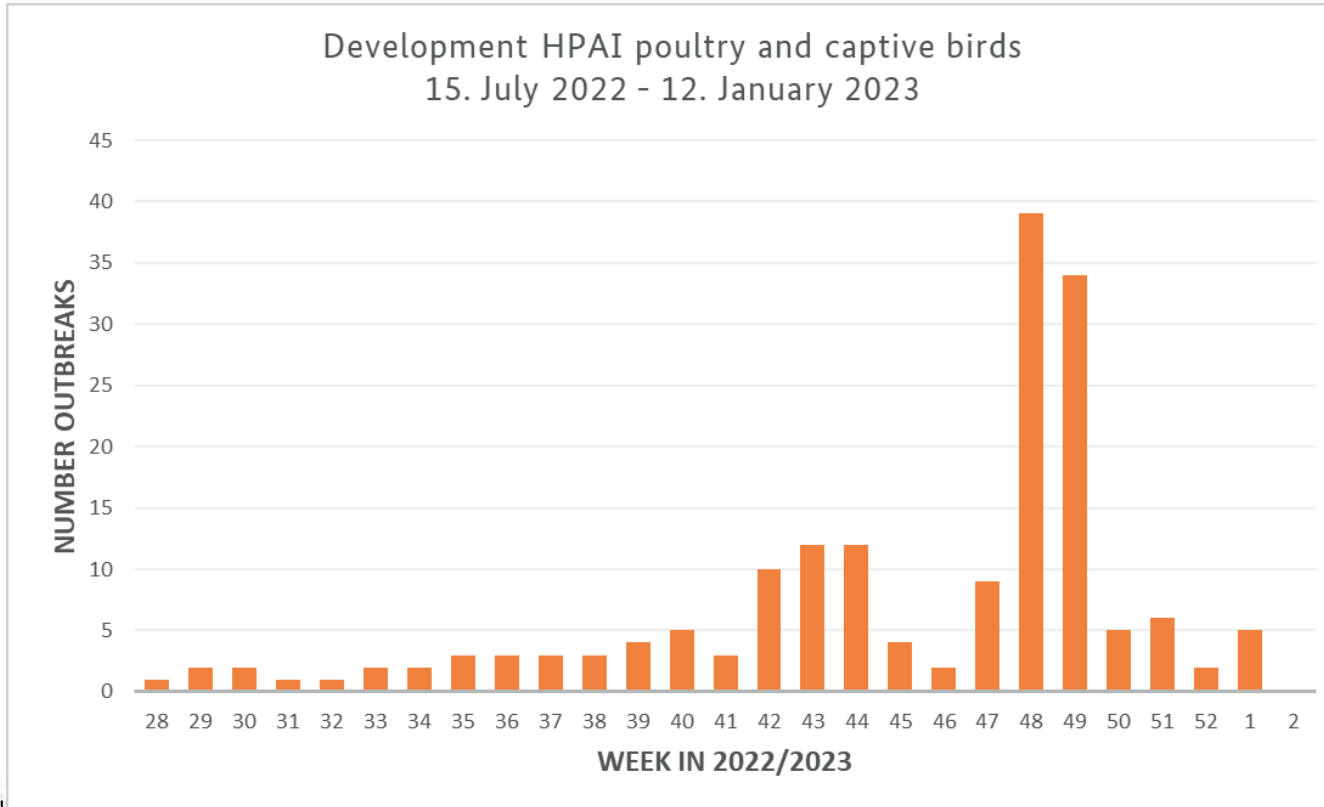


2. Situation in poultry and captive birds

| Period of time | Number of outbreaks |
|--------------------------------------------------|---------------------|
| Active outbreaks on 12/01/2023 | 103 |
| New from 15/12/2022 (last PAFF) until 12/01/2023 | 15 |
| New season from 15/07/2022 until 12/01/2023 | 176 (73 lifted) |

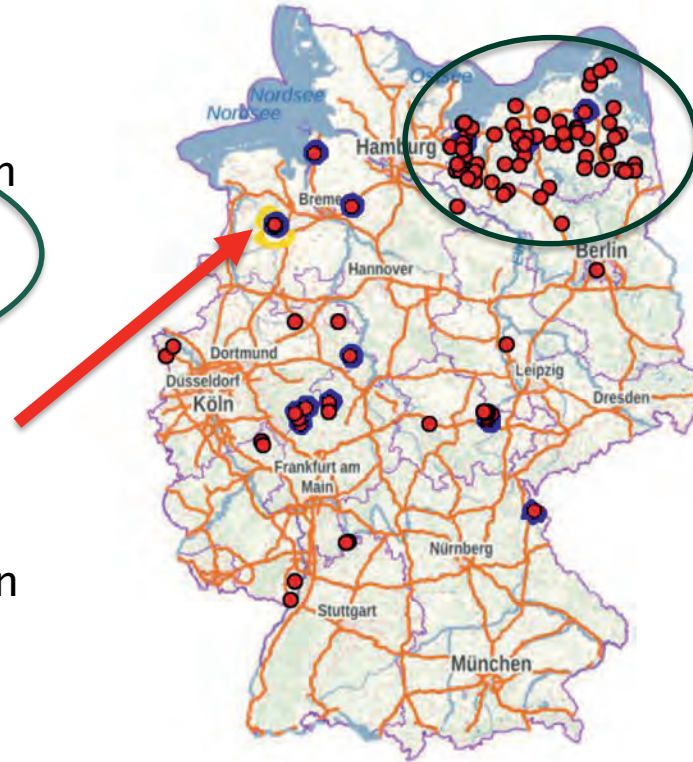


2. Outbreaks in poultry and captive birds

Particular events:

No more new secondary outbreaks in Mecklenburg–Western Pomerania since 20/12/2022. Total number of secondary outbreaks: 60.

Additional HPAI disease control measure in Lower Saxony: The district of Cloppenburg issued a restocking ban in accordance with Article 71 (1) of Regulation (EU) 2016/429 for turkeys in establishments within certain communes with high density of



3. Particular events/Summary

Outbreaks in captive birds:

- Things have calmed down significantly in **Mecklenburg–Western Pomerania (MV)**
- The chain of infection was successfully broken
- New secondary outbreaks from 15/12/2022 (last PAFF: 56) until 12/01/2023 in MV **four**
- Since 20/12/2022 no new secondary outbreaks. Total number of outbreaks: **60**.
- No new secondary outbreaks in other Länder. No outbreaks at all in other MS.

Outbreaks in poultry:

- Since last PAFF **five** outbreaks in turkey establishments (for fattening) in Lower Saxony, four in the district of Cloppenburg.
- Due to the high risk the competent authorities issued a restocking ban in accordance with Article 71 (1) of Regulation (EU) 2016/429 for turkeys in establishments within certain communes with a high density of turkeys.
- The ban is established for a period of 30 days.
