

ESF+: WHAT IS AT STAKE NOW IN THE EU



The number of people coming to our associations for help is increasing very rapidly and massively, and for a long lasting period



The alimentary crisis is strong and will last because of inflation. It is causing more people to come for help, and lower volume of food from the ESF+



The **volunteers** that come to help those in need are themselves limited in their activities because of inflation and living costs (e.g. fuel and transportation)



Operational costs supported by associations are now at a peak, making our role harder

Inflation is causing a structural destabilization of the economic and social situation of the people we support, as well as a destabilization of our association's financial balance

The ESF+ and the support from the European union is absolutely necessary to the member states' social policies, as it allows European food aid associations to have access to food and essential goods.
