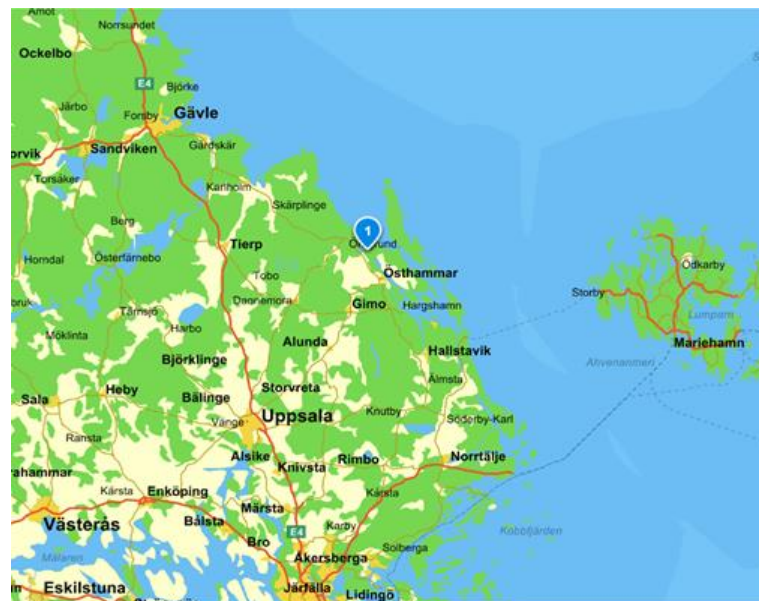


Outbreak of HPAI H5N6 in a non-commercial holding with other captive birds

- HPAI H5N6 was confirmed 15/03/2018
- Non-commercial backyard holding with 105 other captive birds (non-poultry) of different species.
- 18 of the birds died and 1 was found sick.
- No commercial farms within more than 10 km.
- No contacts with other farms and no other relevant contacts.
- With reference to Article 16, Dir. 2005/94 including an overall assessment no restriction zones have been established.

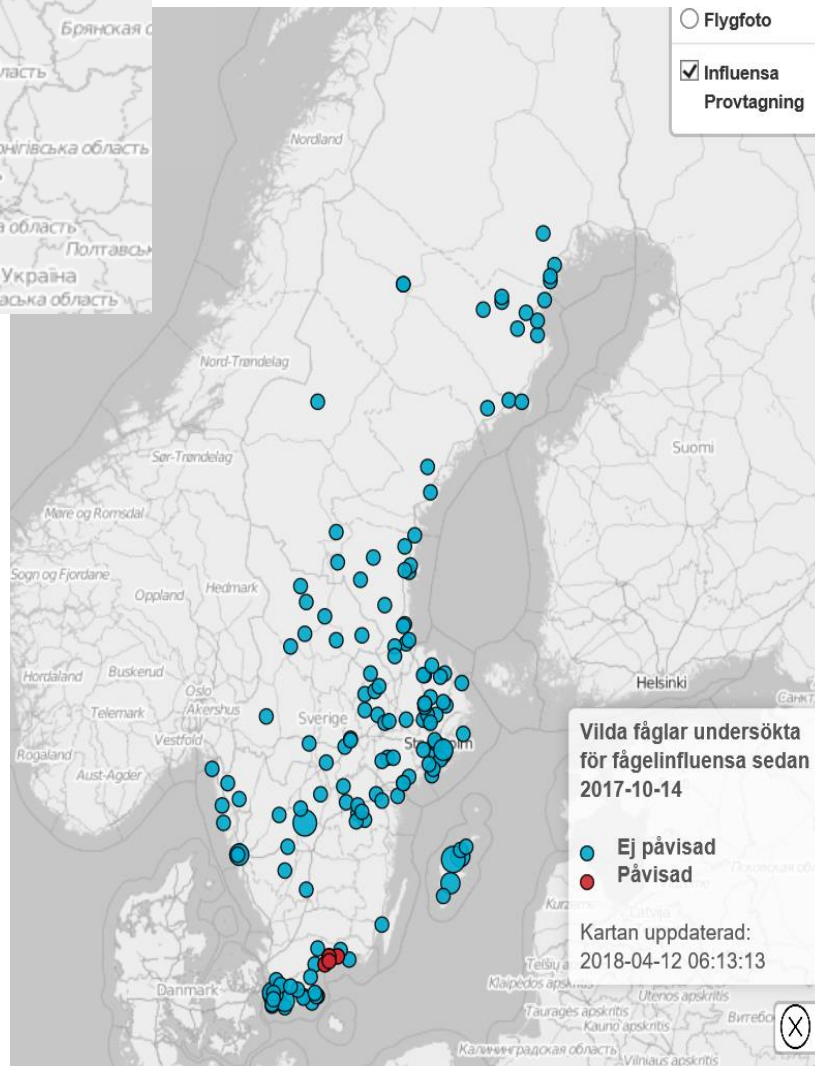
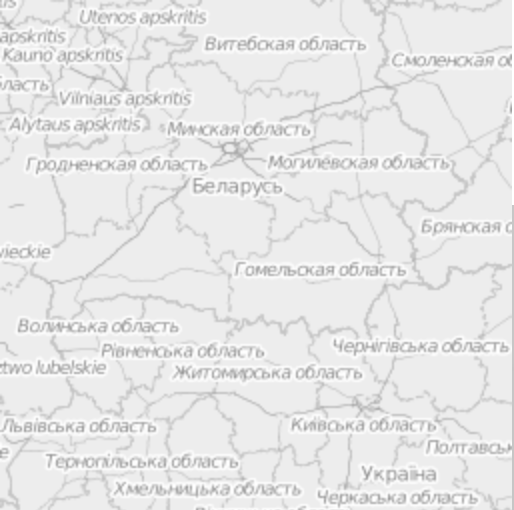
Outbreak of HPAI H5N6 in a non-commercial holding with other captive birds

- All necessary measures according to Directive 2005/94 are applied including stamping out and destruction of all the birds.
- Preliminary disinfection was concluded 16 March 2018.
- Due to the circumstances of this holding we need to establish specific procedures for cleansing and disinfection in accordance with Annex VI, Dir. 2005/94. All the details are not decided yet.
- The holding is situated in Östhammar near the east coast in the middle of Sweden in the County Uppsala län.
