Information on the submission of the final reports for the 2023 veterinary programmes grants

- It will be the **first time of reporting through EGRANT** (Funding and Tenders Portal) and you will be requested to submit 1 report per work package (disease).
- The data will have to be encoded in DG SANTE IT tool (SANTE Data Collection Platform (SDCP) for the last time and then uploaded to EGRANT.
- Grant beneficiaries will use **DG SANTE Data Collection Platform (SDCP)** to prepare work packages' (WPs; programmes) specific final reports:



Information on the submission of the final reports for the 2023 veterinary programmes grants

- WPs final report templates in SDCP are same as in previous years;
- SDCP is expected to be opened for users in EU and relevant non-EU countries as of 04 March 2024;
- The **link** to be followed will be sent to all MSs and TCs contact points by end of February 2024
- □ HaDEA recommends to submit WPs specific reports via SDCP by 30 March 2023;
- HaDEA stresses the importance of double checking the data/information encoded, before the submission via SDCP. This may prevent re-submission of reports via SDCP and also re-upload/over-administration in eGrants.

Information on the submission of the final reports for the 2023 veterinary programmes grants

- Detailed **Guidelines** on **how to upload** work packages' specific final reports (prepared in SDCP) in EGRANT as well as on **how to encode** required information/data will be sent to the project coordinators **by 25 February 2024**.
- The deadline to submit required information, on the implementation of veterinary programmes in 2023, via eGrants is 30 April 2024.
- HaDEA will continue providing all necessary support to colleagues on the beneficiaries' side during the reporting process.
