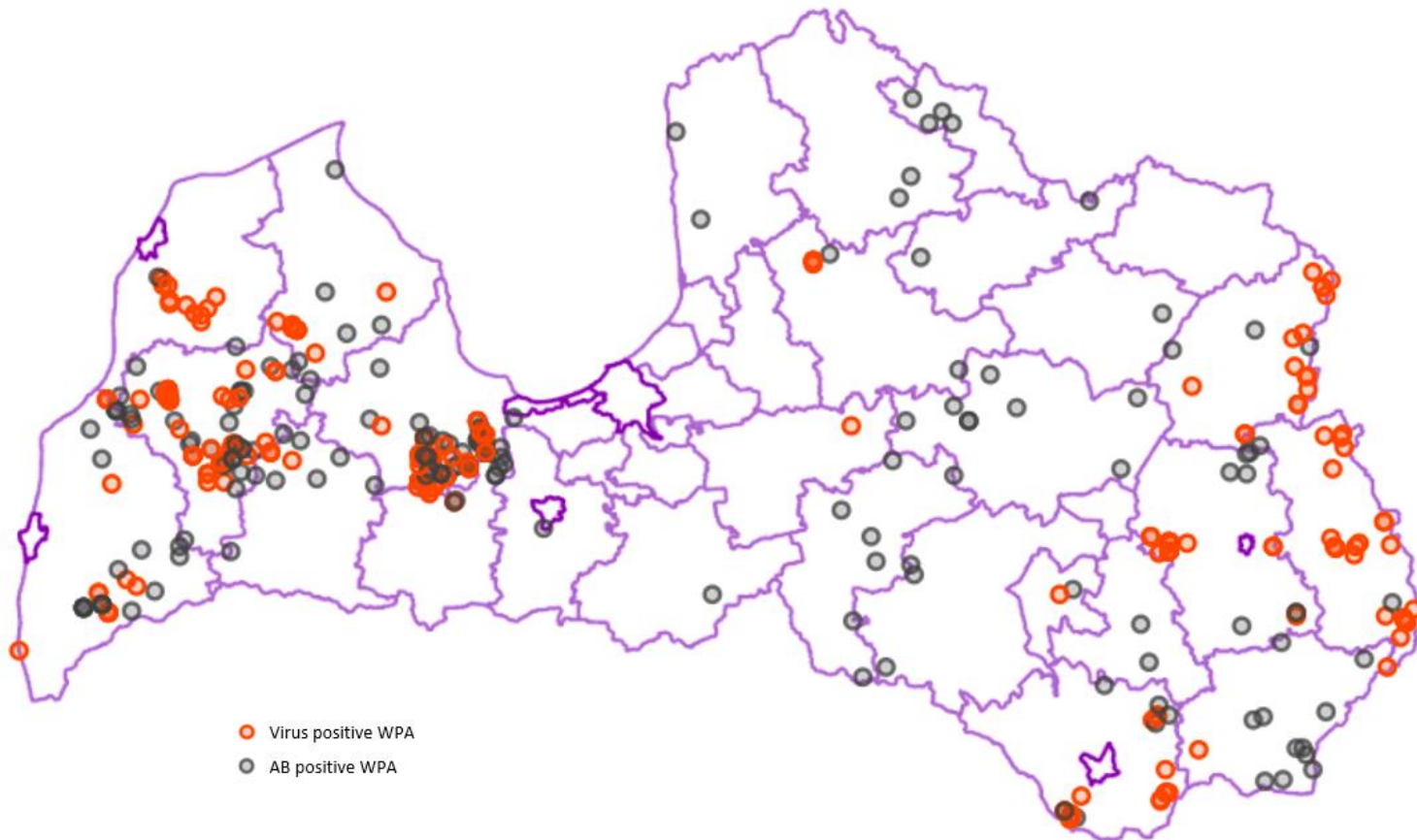
ASF epidemiological situation in Latvia – 2021 (update)

Wild porcine animal cases in 2021 (till 13th December)



Sampling and testing:

19 525- samples from hunted wild porcine animals

226 - samples from found dead wild porcine animals

In total **397** ASF cases in wild porcine animals (286 hunted, 111 found dead)
ASF virus positive 216 cases, seropositive 181 cases

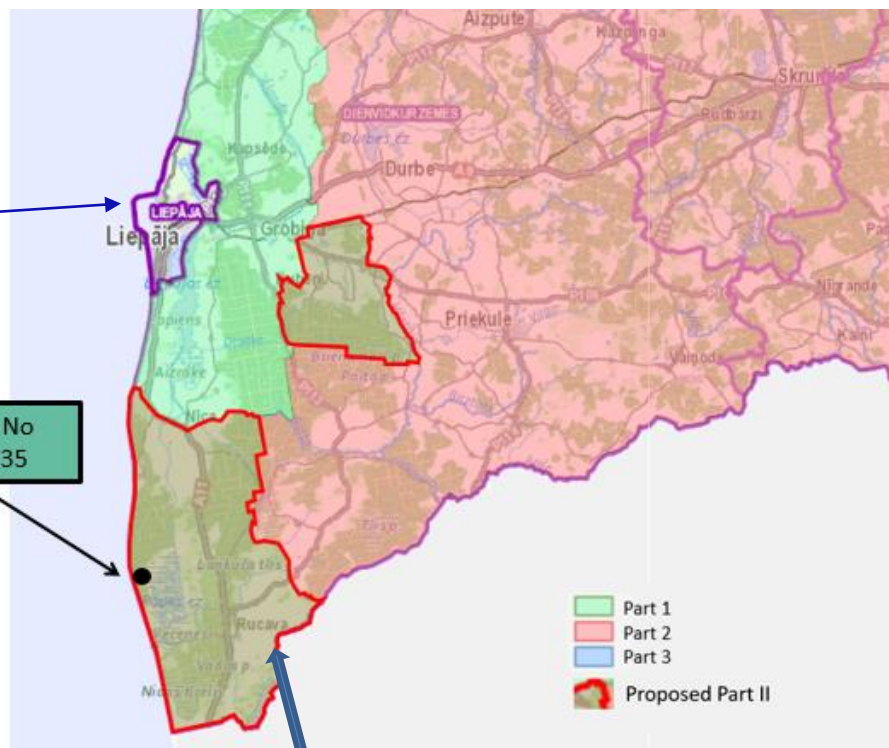
Enlargement of Part II

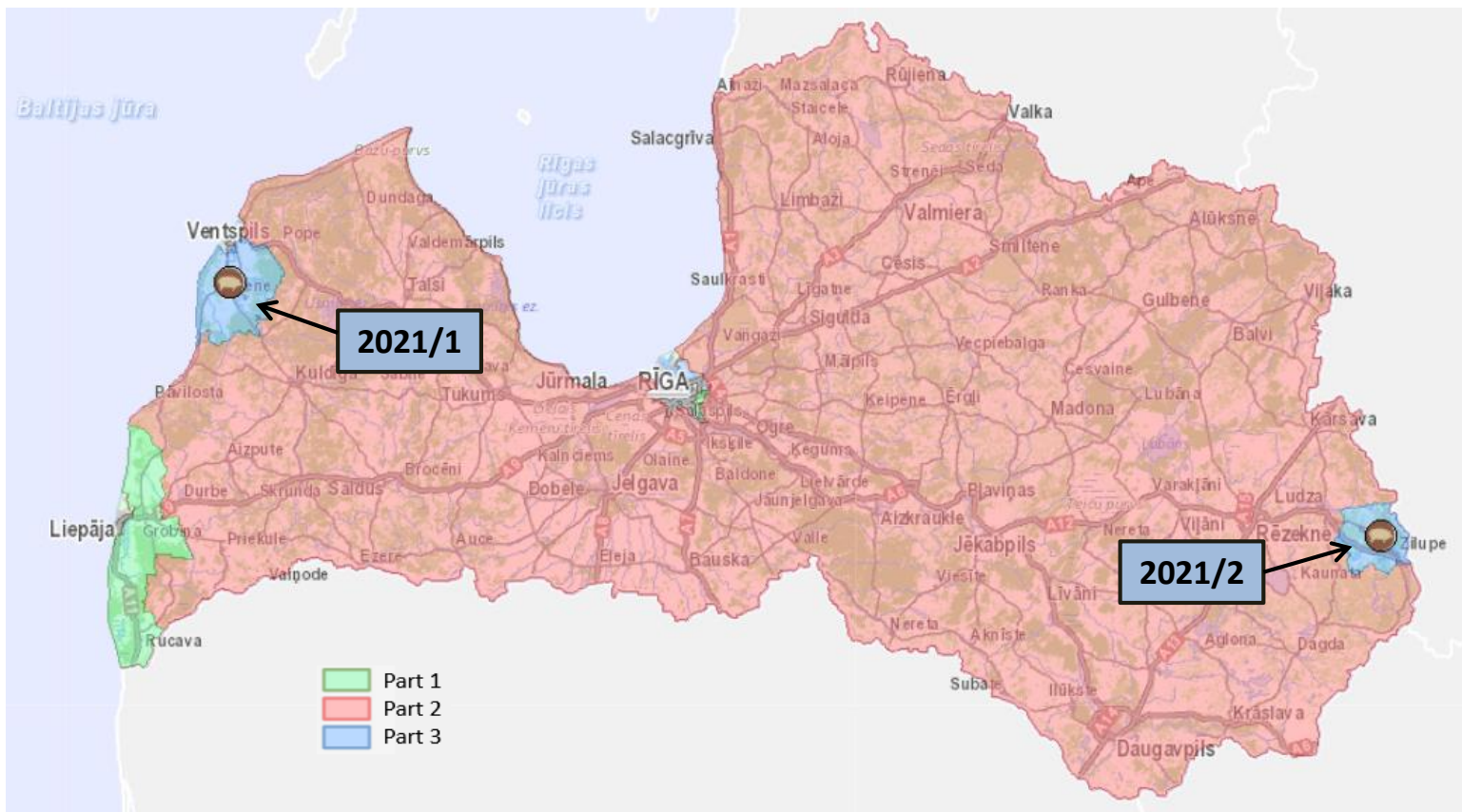
ASF case in one dead wild porcine animal was confirmed on 6th December in the area listed in Part I (in the Dienvidkurzemes county, Rucavas parish)

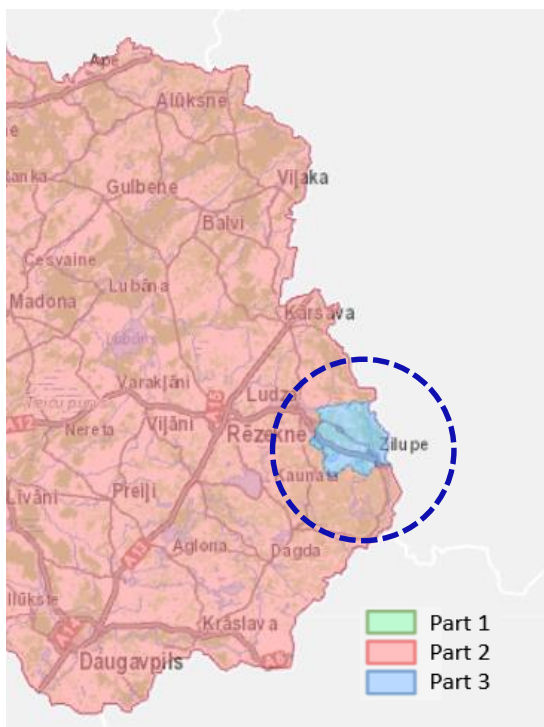

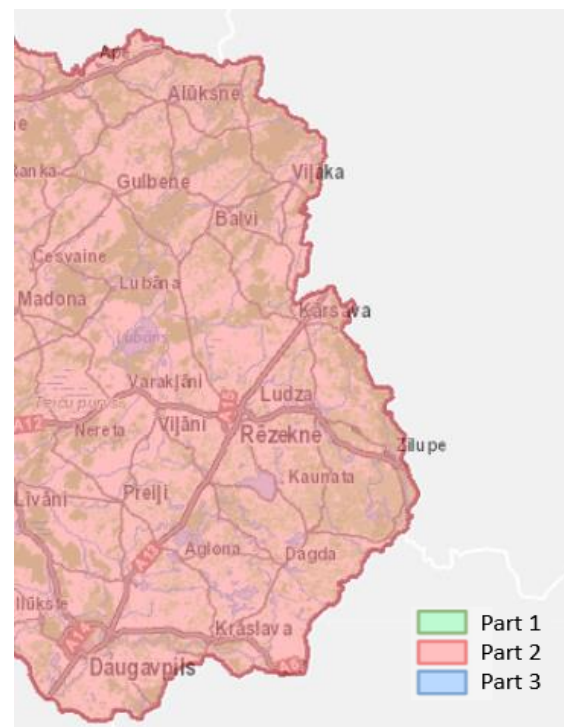
Application for lifting certain areas of Part III

Based on the Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/605 and Commission working document SANTE/7112/2015:

- At least 3 months after the disinfection of the infected establishments have past;
- Clinical examinations have been carried out;
- Passive surveillance system for establishments of kept porcine animals has been implemented;
- Active and passive surveillance for wild porcine animals has been implemented.

Application for lifting certain areas of Part III

ASF surveillance in kept porcine animals in Part III

- Clinical examinations have been carried out with favorable results

- Biosecurity checks:
 - there are 76 registered establishments
 - 108 inspections on biosecurity requirements have been carried out in 76 establishments
 - in 20 cases in the establishments insignificant incompliances were identified which were rectified during the inspections

**Number of wild porcine animals tested to ASF in Part III
(active and passive surveillance)**

Dead wild porcine animals	4
Hunted wild porcine animals	62
