
BT situation: begining of vector activity season 2023

BTV-4 in Madrid, Coruña and Asturias (10th November)




Detection of BTV-4 circulation in A Coruña, Asturias and Madrid

Adaptation of zone with program






BTV-4 in Murcia (20th November)

Previous BTV-1 notification: December 2021




Baleares BT situation (application for free status)

✓The 26th November 2023: 24 months without circulation

✓ All conditions set out in point (a) of Article 66 and with Annex V of Commission Delegated Regulation 689/2020

✓ Proposal for disease free status





Conclusions BT epidemiological situation in Spain

> BT zone with program has been expanded in 2023

- BT viral circulation in spite of compulsory vaccination program:
 - wild animal population;
 - new zones with program without enough vaccination coverage;
 - viral introduction from North Africa
