



# **Animal density in Austria: Poultry**



#### Farm density in Austria: Poultry holdings




#### **Active surveillance in Austria 2023: all categories of holdings**




#### Passive surveillance in Austria 2023: Wild birds




#### Passive surveillance in Austria 2023: poultry and captive birds




## Areas of high risk and very high risk - December 2023 to February 2024

## Wild birds

- 13 wild birds (5 outbreaks) in four Federal Provinces
  - 8 ducks in *Burgenland*
  - 2 mute swans in Salzburg
  - 2 mute swans in Upper Austria
  - 1 greylag goose in Styria

H5N1 confirmed in all outbreaks



# **Non-poultry**


- 1 outbreak in small backyard flock since the last outbreak on 05.02.2024: Upper Austria, district Braunau
  - Confirmation on 04.10.2024: *H5N1*
  - Mixed flock: chicken, geese, pheasants
  - Measures according to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687
  - Exception from zoning in this outbreaks of non-poultry backyard flocks



#### **Poultry**


- **1 outbreak** since the last outbreak on 02.02.2023: Upper Austria, district Braunau
  - Confirmation on 09.10.2024: *H5N1*
  - 75 chickens, 22 turkeys, 16 ducks and 12 guinea fowl
  - Preliminary cleansing & disinfection: 10.10.2024



- Frequent meetings of the Task Force group Avian Influenza
  - Administration, AGES, stakeholders, Vetmeduni Vienna
  - Presentation of the disease status in Austria and other European countries
  - Discussion on measures (extention of zones, risk assessment) and on communication to the public
  - Co-ordination of information-material and organisation of lectures for representatives of administration and stakeholders

## **Measures in Austria**

- Regular and ad hoc meetings of the expert group (BMG, AGES, affected federal states)
- Meeting with affected federal state (Oberösterreich) on 09.10.2024
- Preparation of a weekly HPAI report by AGES-DSR
- Regular preparations of a risk assessment by AGES-IVET Mödling (last update on 16.10.2024)
- Avian influenza task force on 17.10.2024
- Meeting with the provincial veterinary directors on 20.11.2024
- Amendment of the Avian Influenza Regulation, definition of an area with high risk or very high risk of avian influenza
