

## ASF in Lithuania in wild boars



#### 2023

- 291 hunted wild boar
- 292 found dead wild boar
   In total:
   436 ADIS notifications / 583
   affected wild boars


#### 2024

- 46 hunted wild boar
- 153 found dead wild boar

In total:
121 ADIS notifications / 202
affected wild boars



### **V/VV** ASF in Lithuania in wild boars 2024



From 15 February, only the PCR test method for wild boars is applied in Lithuania (hunted wild boars are no longer tested by ELISA)

Areas where the virus is detected within 12 months, all hunted wild boars are tested by PCR

Areas where the virus is not detected in 12 months, hunted wild boars are selected for testing of PCR according to prevalence




# ASF in Lithuania in domestic pigs

3 outbreaks in DP establishments in 2023

- 2 non-commercial (8 pigs).
- 1 commercial (22 pigs).


No ASF outbreaks in domestic pigs since July 2023





# ASF in Lithuania in domestic pigs

Application for lifting certain areas from Part III and revert to PART II



Based on the Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/687 and African swine fever in the Union ('ASF guidelines') (C/2023/1504) of 18 December 2023:

- At least 12 months after the disinfection of the infected establishments are past;
- Clinical examinations are carried out;
- Passive surveillance system for establishments of kept porcine animals is implemented;
- Active and passive surveillance for wild porcine animals are implemented.
