



HOW TO STUN PIGS

Stunning is vital to make pigs unconscious before slaughtering them. They can then be **slaughtered** painlessly.

The tips below cover best practices used in small slaughterhouses and will help you stun pigs efficiently.

Only workers holding a certificate of competence are allowed to stun pigs.

ABOUT PIGS

- ♣ Pigs are social, sensitive and expressive animals
- They don't have good eyesight, but can hear very well
- ♦ Sows and boars can be aggressive
- **↑ Like**: well-lit areas
- Dislike: darkness and shadows, reflections, moving objects, strong drafts, loud noises, sudden movement, being on their own and in a corner, slippery floors, being hurried
- ★ Each pig can respond in a different way.

POSITIONING
OF ELECTRODES
FOR STUNNING OF PIGS



BEFORE STUNNING

CHECK THE EQUIPMENT

- ★ Make sure the tongs are the right size and not corroded.
- Wet the electrodes to ease current flow
- Wear rubber gloves and boots

PLACE THE ELECTRODES

- Between the outer corners of the eyes and the base of the ears
- Or just below the ears
- Or below one ear and above the opposite eye
- Never place behind the ears

WHEN PIGS ARE AGITATED





- ★ Keep calm
- Reassure with gentle movements and a soft voice





Shout or use violence – this makes the situation worse





DURING STUNNING

RECOMMENDED PARAMETERS FOR HEAD-ONLY ELECTRICAL STUNNING			
Minimum voltage (volts – V)	Minimum current (amperes – A)	Frequency (hertz – Hz)	Minimum duration (seconds)
>250	1.3 Up to 2 for large pigs	50-800	3

CHECK FOR CONSCIOUSNESS Make sure the animal is unconscious **SIGNS OF LOSS** before sticking. no attempt to stand **OF CONSCIOUSNESS IN PIGS** no blinking (spontaneous or when the eyes are touched) no response to pinching of the nose or ear no regular breathing stiff muscles. followed by twitching leas no noise

AFTER STUNNING

IF THE PIG IS STILL CONSCIOUS

- ♣ Don't bleed it
- Stun again with the back-up method (e.g. penetrative captive bolt)
- Identify what went wrong
- Correct any problems before resuming stunning

QUICKLY BLEED THE PIG

Stick the chest with a sharp knife to induce blood loss. This should happen within 15 seconds of stunning.

CONFIRM THE DEATH

Check for:

- ♦ No spontaneous movement
- → Limp body
- No response to pinching of the nose or ear
- ♣ No noise
- No regular breathing pigs may gasp in the moments before death
- No blinking if you touch the eyes
- ♣ Eyes rolled upwards
- → Dilated pupils
- → Bleeding stopped
- No heartbeat
