$1. \ \ ANALYSIS \ OF THE \ MAJOR \ DEFICIENCIES \ DETECTED \ DURING \ THE \ NON-DISCRIMINATORY \ INSPECTIONS$

For the purpose of this annual report, the following have been considered to be major deficiencies:

All categories of non-compliance listed as items 1 to 6 in the first column of Table 2

2. ACTION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE DEFICIENCIES DESCRIBED UNDER POINT 1.

In terms of an Action Plan, we continue to monitor the annual rate of major non-compliances found by local authorities reported by APHA Region. The average percentage reported by LAs in 2016 remained low at 0.96%. This compares with 0.89% in 2015, 0.86% in 2014 and 0.72% in 2013.

A key part of the Action plan is to identify those Local Authorities with non-compliance rates of over 5%. In such cases the LA is required to provide an explanation for such a level, and, where appropriate, what actions it intends to take to achieve a reduction. In 2016 the number of Local Authorities which reported non-compliance rates of over 5% were 9. This compares with 12 LAs in 2015, 14 LAs in 2014 and 13 LAs in 2013.
