Economic activity

1. Do we need a definition of “economic activity”?
2. Concrete proposals.
3. Do we need to be more concrete?

Summary:

General agreement on the need of definition and better clarity of this concept in the new legislation.

Policy indicators

1. Possible policy (and other) indicators.
2. Ideas for monitoring and reporting.

Summary:

The lack of indicators in the current legislation is a weak element. Common and harmonised approach is needed in the new legislation.

Journey logs

1. Procedures of approval and control
2. New elements and sections to consider in addition to the current ones

Summary:

Journey logs are also important for authorities other than official vets, e.g. police, traffic inspectors. Room for simplification and harmonised controls in the new legislation.
