



#### The AHL:

- lists five most significant diseases (FMD, CSF, ASF, HPAI, AHS)
- sets out a list of diseases in Annex II which corresponds to the list of diseases annexed to the financial regulation.
- → For those animal diseases listed, different prevention and control rules set out in the AHL apply (categorisation)



The AHL allows reviewing the listed of diseases by a delegated act:

The following parameters have to be assessed (AHL, Art 7):

- disease profile,
- the impact of the disease,
- its potential to generate a crisis situation
- the prevention and control measures available
- the impact of disease prevention and control measures



COM assessment is being carried out EFSA opinions have been requested:

- Aujeszky's disease,
- Enzootic bovine leukosis,
- Bovine viral diarrhoea,
- Infectious bovine rhinotracheitis,
- Porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome,
- Paratuberculosis and
- Koi herpes virus
- Blue tongue
