Cattle, horses, pigs, poultry and sheep.






ANIMAL TRANSPORT FOR EXPORT

(cattle—Turkey)











ANIMAL TRANSPORT >8 hours











ANIMALS EXPORTED (TRACES)










CATTLE EXPORTED (TRACES)


