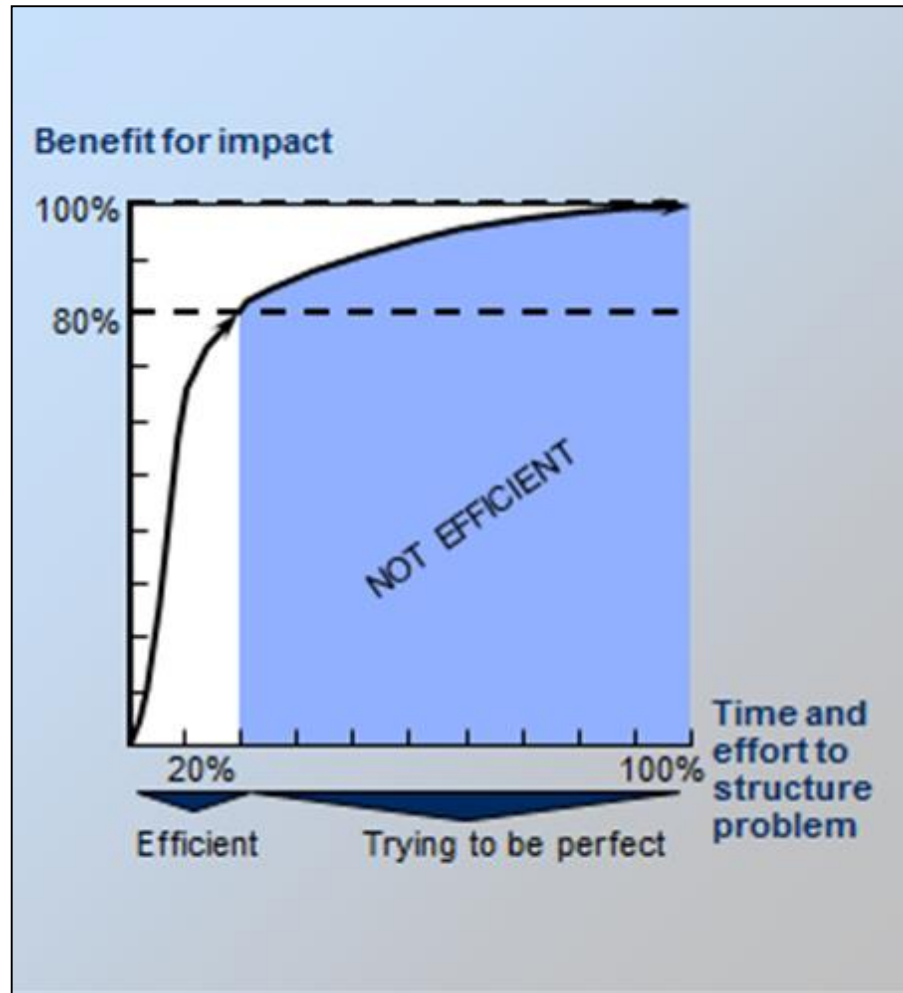
ANIMAL TRANSPORT FOR EXPORT

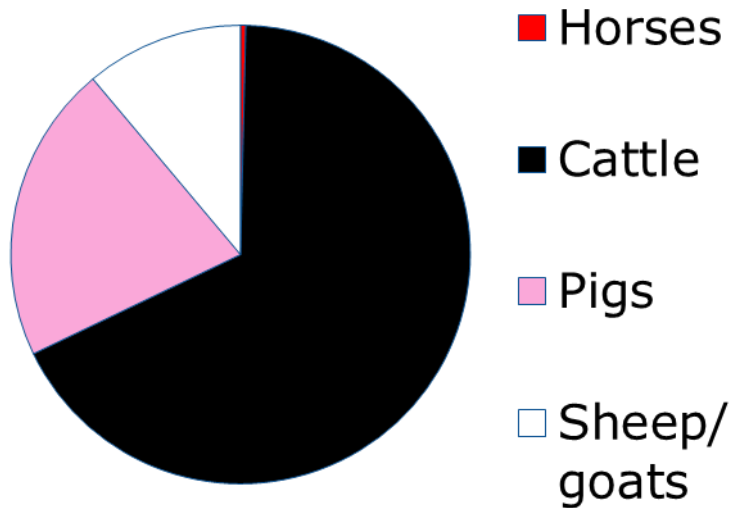

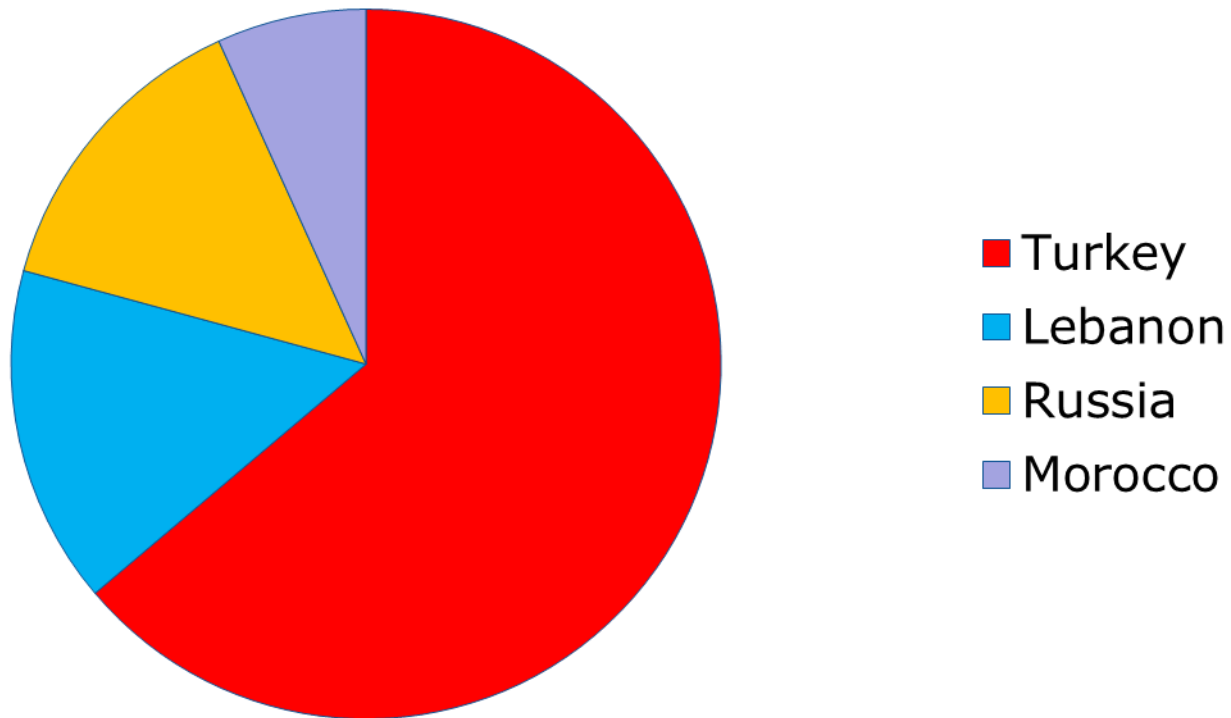

CATTLE EXPORTED (TRACES)

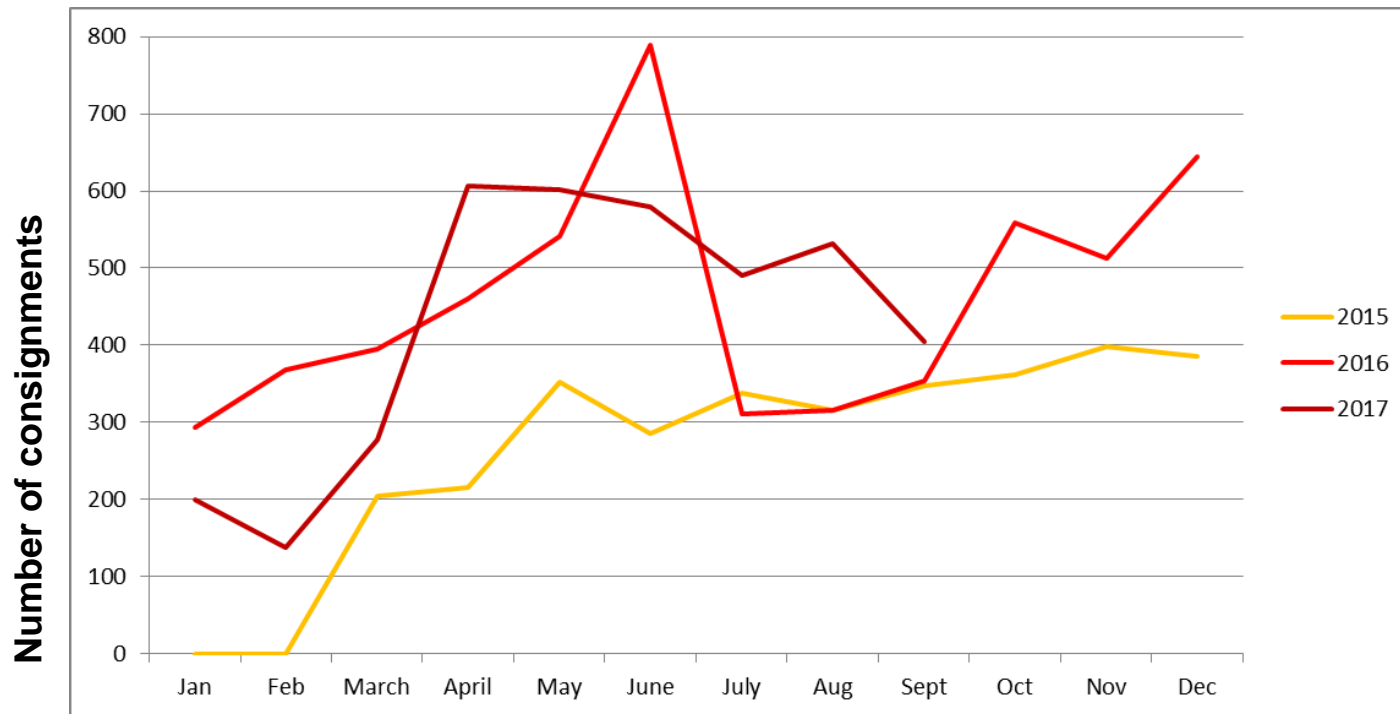

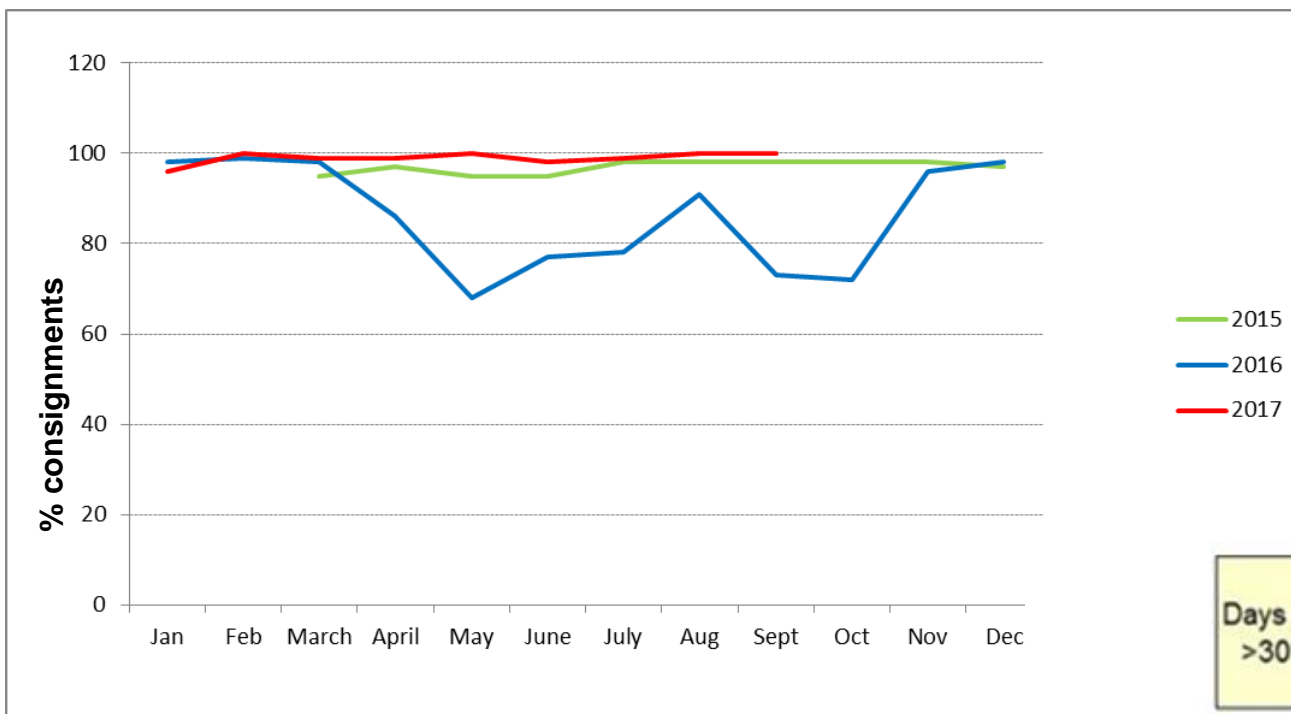
