




## Membership of transport subgroup












### Aims of subgroup

### **Export of cattle**

Deliverable 1 - Factsheet on the organisation of journeys to non-EU countries - **final stages** and adoption soon

- Other deliverables in different stages of development, with a second document very advanced
- Need for a focus on cooperation with third countries
- Next meeting will focus on transport by sea, and innovative ways to improve compliance in cattle exports to non-EU countries





#### Impact of the current transport regime

- Long distance transport of calves is not farm to farm.
- Mostly it is assembly centre to assembly centre.
- This increases the risk of a negative impact on their health and welfare and ability to cope with long distance transport.

#### **Co-ordinator Antonio Velarde (IRTA)**

Q1 Prolonged hunger,

Q2 Thermal comfort,


Q3 Health & fitness

#### Q1 Prolonged hunger:

- Calves need approx. 10-20% of body weight as milk daily;
- Unable to get milk on the truck and might suffer from prolonged hunger (& one hour stop not sufficient to feed them);
- Offer water in addition to milk;
- Animal based measures: cross-sucking and competition for milk, if available.




## **Membership of Pig subgroup**

- 3. Improving management and environment.












## New DG SANTE project: 2019 "Quality controls and indicators"
