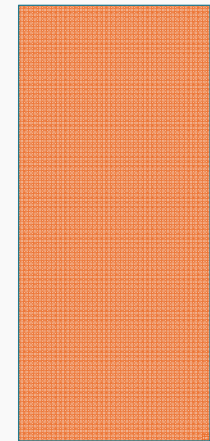

ASF - EPIDEMIOLOGICAL SITUATION

01.01.2019 - 05.07.2019

Domestic pigs:

210 outbreaks with **2278** affected pigs, from which:

- **2** small commercial farms (type A) with 16 affected pigs and
- **208** infected backyards with 2262 affected pigs

Wild boars:

876 positive cases

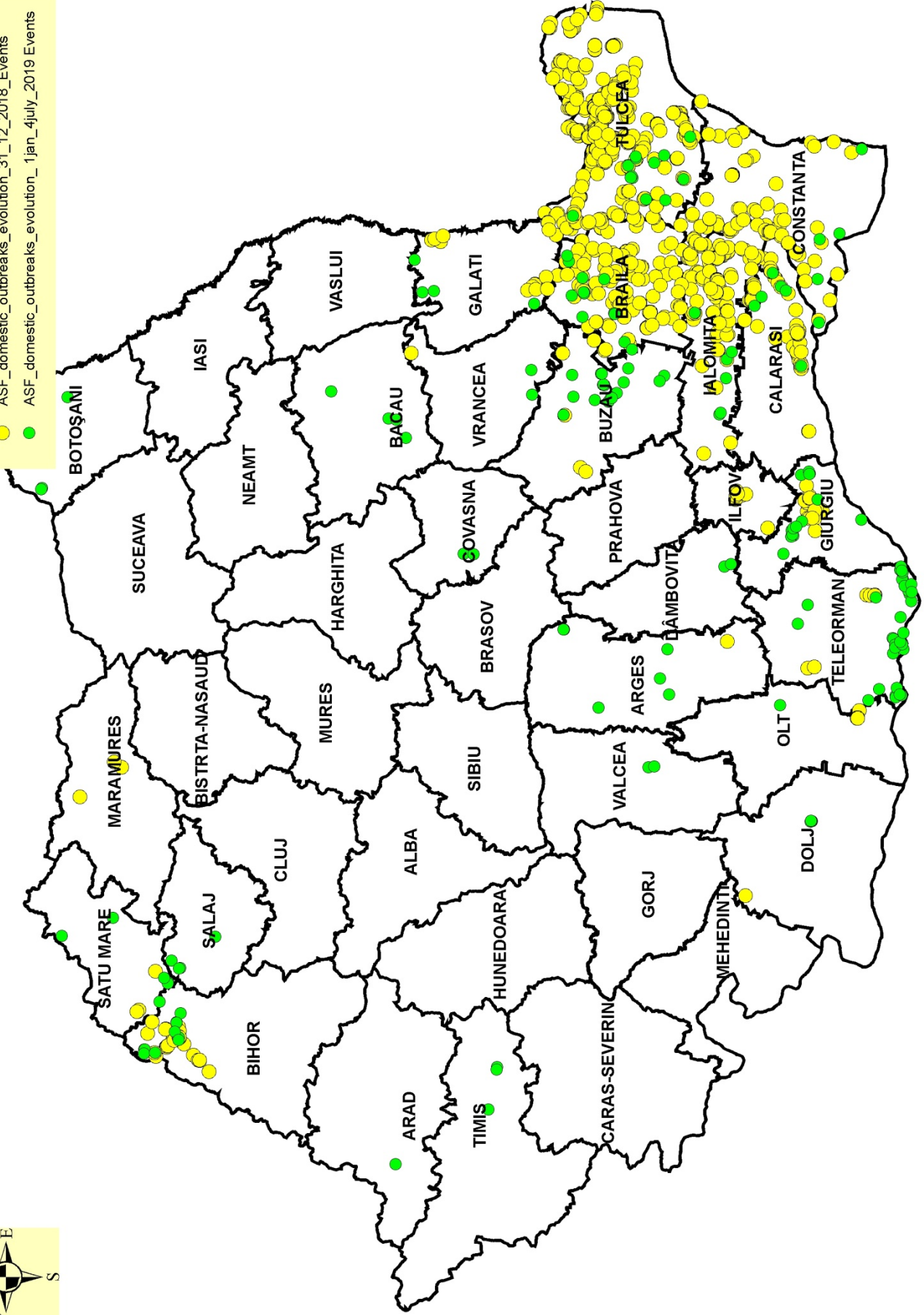
from which: **713** found dead and

163 hunted wild boars

- ASF_domestic_outbreaks_evolution_1jan_4july_2019_Events

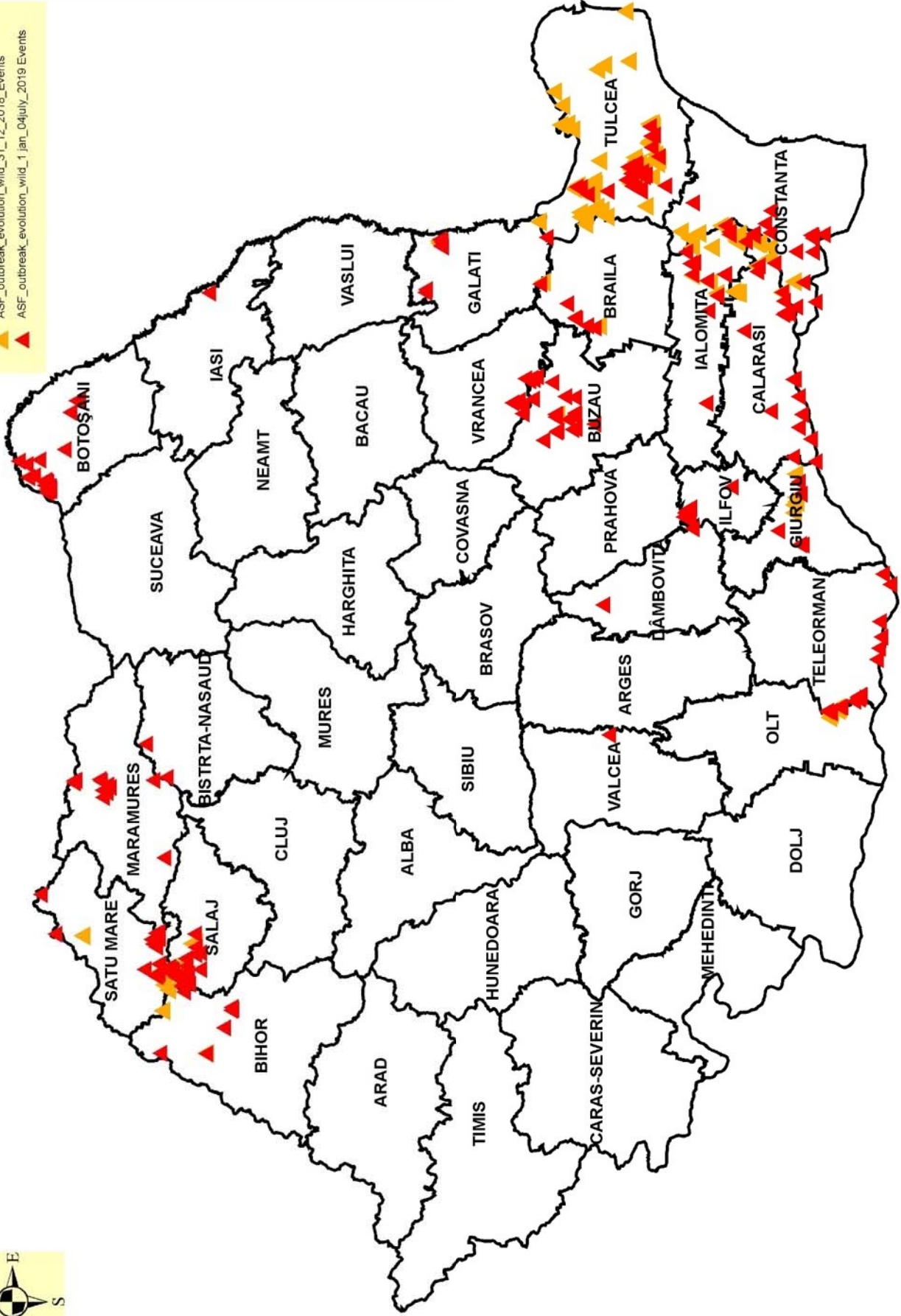

PREVENTIVE CULLING

01.01.2019 - 05.07.2019

As an extraordinary measure, to stop the spreading of the disease, the Local Centre for Disease Control can decide, after a risk analysis is performed, the preventive kill in a certain locality.

Legal framework: Government Decision no. 484 from 5th of July 2018.

All necessary resources are allocated to ensure that no virus is circulating in the restriction zones in order to lift the measures in protection and surveillance zones.

OFFICIAL CONTROLS (1)

NSVFSA performs **controls on non-professional holdings** that pose a high-risk for ASF virus spreading, focusing particularly on holdings:

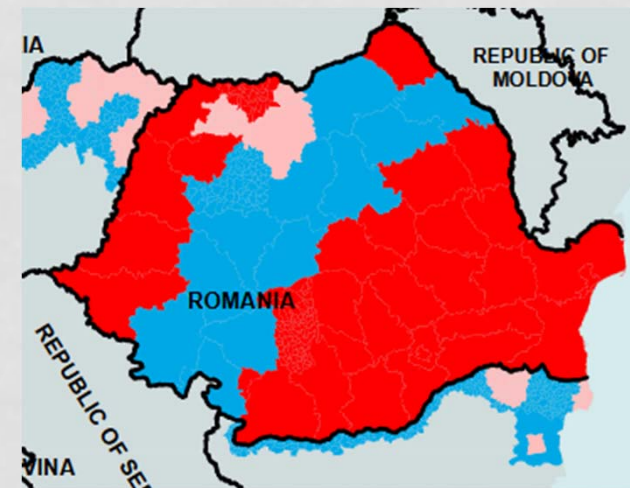
- with more than 5 pigs,
- with adult sows,
- that presents a high risk for commercial activities (selling without legal documents),
- that don't notify the pig movement for registration in the National Data Base

OFFICIAL CONTROLS (2)

The official control campaign is underway, but until June 2019 the results are the following :

Risk area*	Verified holdings	Non-compliant holdings	%

Part II	85	9	10,59%
Part I	959	132	13,76%

OFFICIAL CONTROLS (3)

Among **found deficiencies**:

- Non-compliance with identification and registration rules (unidentified pigs over 60 days, National Data Base not updated, undeclared home slaughter, keeping ear tags after home slaughter, etc)
- Commercial activities without documents
- Non-compliance with national biosecurity requirements (feeding with household waste, lack of disinfecting footwear, lack of work equipment, etc.)

Sanctions:

- Warnings with a deadline to remedy nonconformities
- Fines
- Contraventional sanctions

ASF MEASURES (1)

- **ASF Training**

- May 13-14, 2019

- all 42 county Directorates

- topics for discussion:

- deficiencies identified;
- harmonized procedures at national level;
- epidemiological inquiries;
- plan of measures - uniform application of disease control measures in restricted areas, lifting restrictions, repopulation;
- results of holding inspections.
- noncompliance/nonconformities.

- cascade trainings:** official veterinarians, empowered veterinary practitioners, representatives of commercial farms, representatives of the county Prefecture, hunting grounds managers and hunters;

ASF MEASURES (2)

- 26th of June: **National Videoconference** - Analysis of measures to prevent and control the disease;
- NSVFSA issued **instructions** regarding documents accompanying live pigs intended for slaughter, epidemiological inquiries, implementation of ASF control measures;
- Draft **legislative changes** on minimum biosecurity conditions, animal movements.
- Draft **legislative changes** on establishing and sanctioning contraventions to sanitary and food safety norms.

AWARNNESS CAMPAIGN

The posters of the OIE awareness campaign have been translated into Romanian language and distributed to inform farmers, hunters, travelers and transporters.

Nu fiți purtătorul unei boli mortale pentru porci

Pesta porcină africană (PPA) nu constituie un pericol pentru oameni, dar ucide porci domestici și sălbatici. Nu există un vaccin. Virusul este puternic rezistent în mediu și în produsele din carne de porc. Neglijența poate răspândi boala.

Respectați PRECAUȚIILE generale

Declarați orice caz suspect (animal decedat sau viu) Serviciilor Veterinare.

Nu transportați porci sau produse din carne de porc. Dacă trebuie să transportați animale, declarați autorităților.

Atunci când lucrați în cadrul fermelor sau vizitați ferme, respectați măsurile de biosecuritate.

Nu vizitați ferme de porci din zonele afectate.

CRESCĂTORII DE PORCI
Lușiți măsurile în gospodăria dumneavoastră și în pielea pentru a proteja porcii și pe cei ai vecinilor de riscul îmbolnăvirii cu PPA.

FERME COMERCIALE DE PORCI
Intensificați măsurile de biosecuritate în ferma dumneavoastră.

ATENȚIE, VÂNTĂTORII
În timpul partidelor de vânțătoare, în special în locurile considerate cu risc de PPA, asigurați-vă că vă dezinfectați echipamentul înainte de a părăsi zona de vânțătoare.

ATENȚIE, CĂLĂTORII
Nu fiți purtătorii virusului transportând porci sau produse din carne de porc.

AUTORITĂȚILE DE TRANSPORT ȘI PERSONALUL DE LA PUNȚELE DE CONTROL (aeroporturi, porturi, gări, autostrăzi)
Informați-vă cu privire la țările infectate cu PPA și verificați sistematic călătoria care transportă animale sau produse de origine animală, în special porci sau produse din carne de porc.
