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The national Pact against food waste

- France has succeeded in mobilizing all stakeholders by launching the National Pact against Food Waste.
- This pact, set up in 2013 and renewed in 2017, brings together voluntary public or private players from the entire food chain.






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National "anti-food waste" label (ACELIAL, 2020)

- ✓ **Objective : value** any actor in the food chain who contributes to the national objectives of reducing food waste.
- ✓ Actors targeted : distributors, collective and private catering, food industry and primary production.
- ✓ Can be obtained with 3 levels of progression in order to enhance the efforts already made and to encourage the actors to improve
- ✓ This system will ultimately help to guide consumer choices and create a virtuous dynamic for the companies concerned.



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




General legislative framework

- ✓ 2016: Garot law specifies a hierarchy of actions to combat food waste
- ✓ **2020**: **AGEC** law **defines** food waste
- ✓ 2020: AGEC law sets national targets for reducing food waste
- ✓ 2016=>2019: Ban of the destruction of edible food for distributors (2016: Garot law), collective catering operators and the agri-food industry (2018 Egalim law).

Food waste hierarchy¹



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Specific legislative framework



In France food donation leads to tax reduction (60 % of the value of the donation)

Food donation

- Obligation to offer a partnership to a food aid association to targeted actors
- 2019 (Egalim law): Implementation of a donation quality management plan to ensure quality, involving staff training and awareness.

For the commercial catering sector

 The EGalim law (2018) introduces the obligation for commercial catering operators to offer a recyclable reusable container to take away uneaten food - equivalent to the doggy bag (implemented in 2021)

Obligation to carry out a waste diagnosis

- 2019 (Egalim law) : Collective catering sector
- 2020 (AGEC law): Agri-food industries sector



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
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Food waste in France – 2021 - EUROSTAT

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Elaboration of a new policy of France to fight against food waste

- The data sets sent to the Commission show that France has still to improve its policy
- The fight against food waste is a process of continuous improvement
- The national strategy for food, nutrition and climate is currently being drawn up, involving all the ministries concerned, to establish the roadmap for food policy up to 2030. The fight against food waste will play a key role in this strategy.

Examples of orientations raised during the consultation process (under discussion):

Raising consumer awareness to reduce food waste

Strengthening the implementation of regulatory provisions (strengthen the deployment of inspections)

Development of initiatives at **territorial level**, whether through territorial food projects or networks to fight food waste

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
